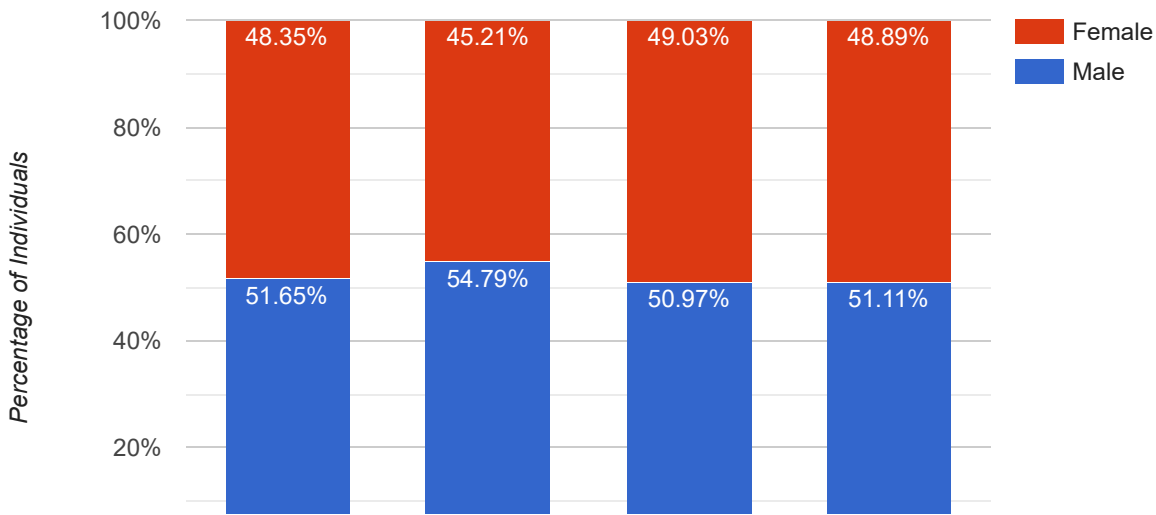

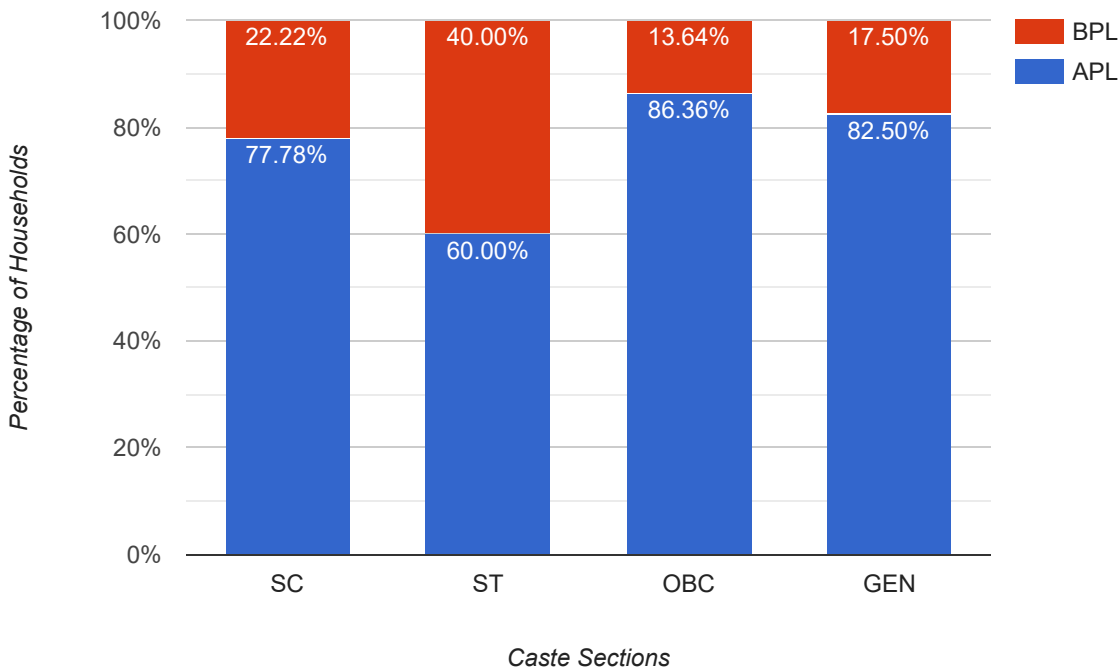

**Gender Wise Population Across Age Groups**



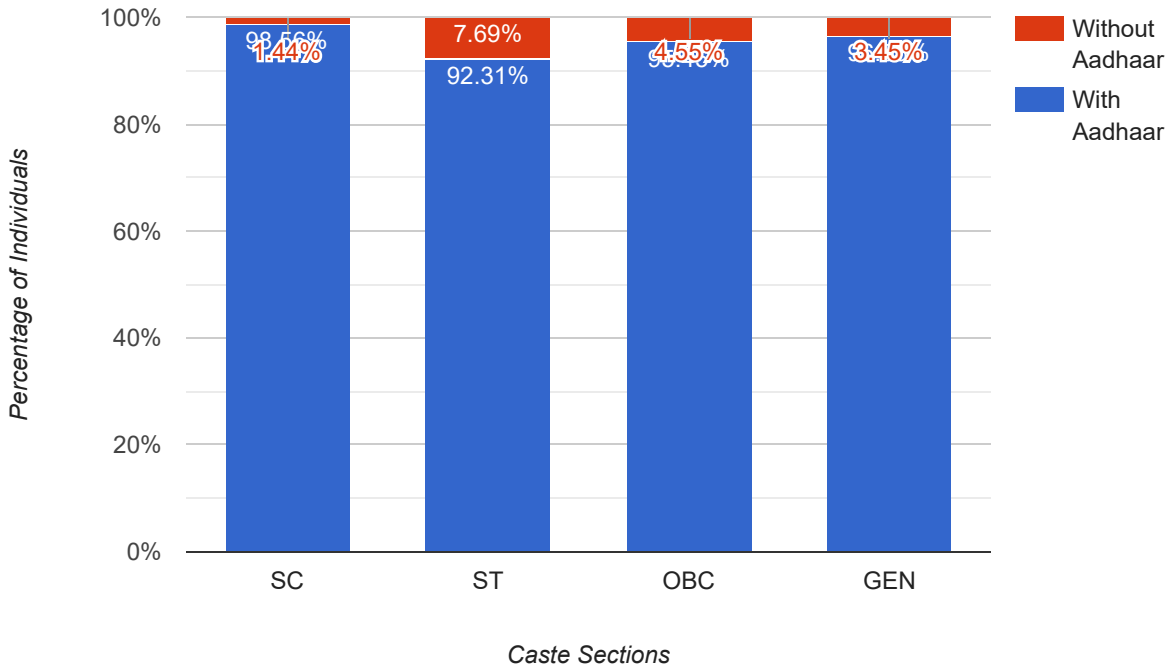
**Poverty Line across prevailing caste sections**

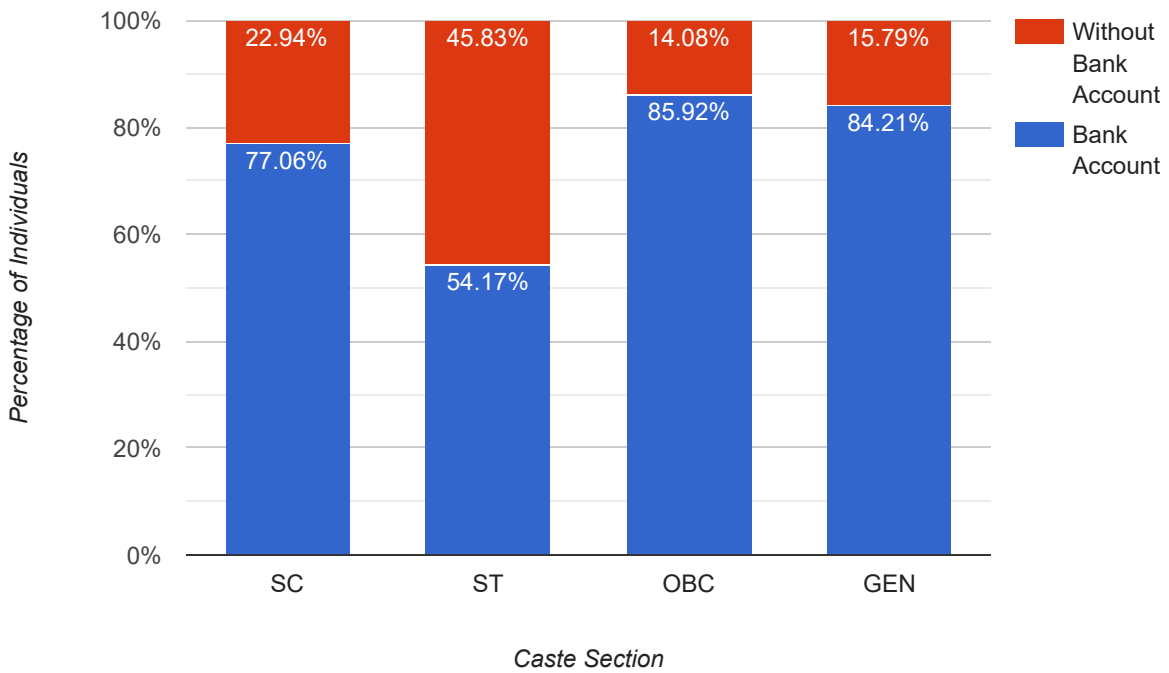

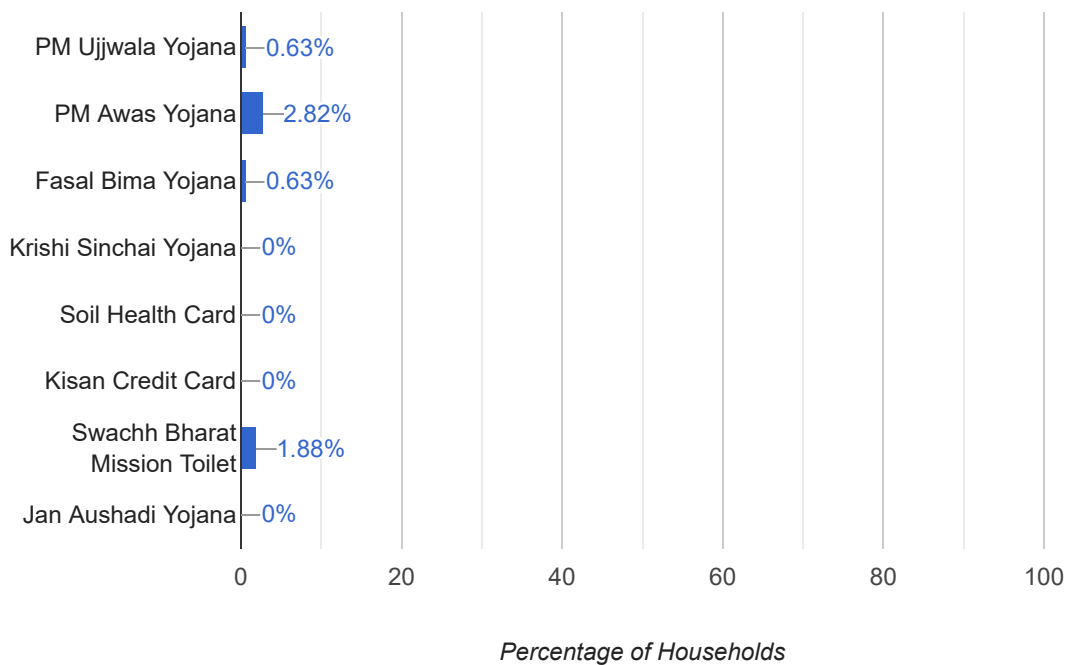
**Bank Coverage across Prevailing Caste Section**

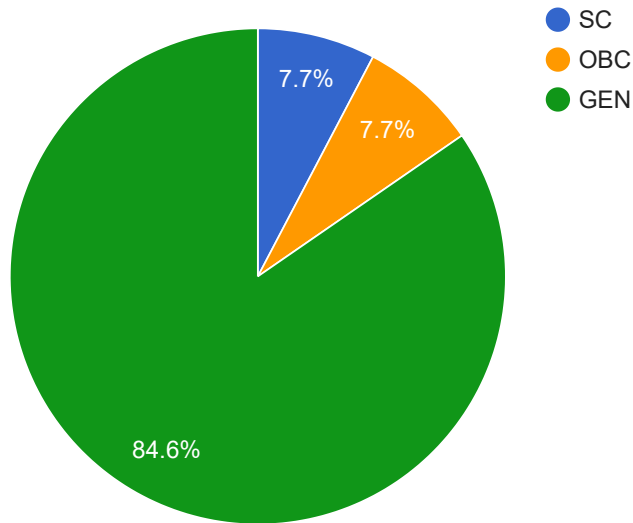

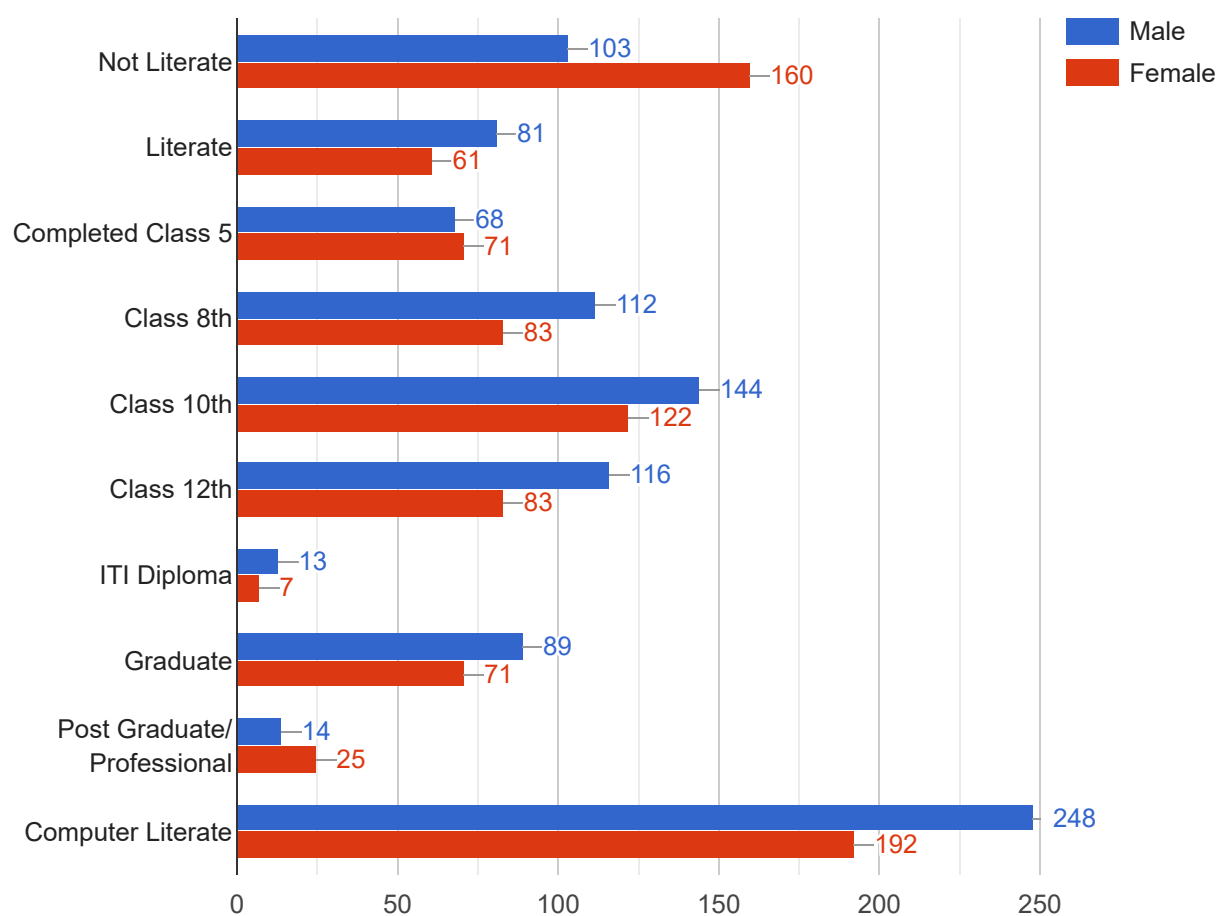

### Drinking Water Facility



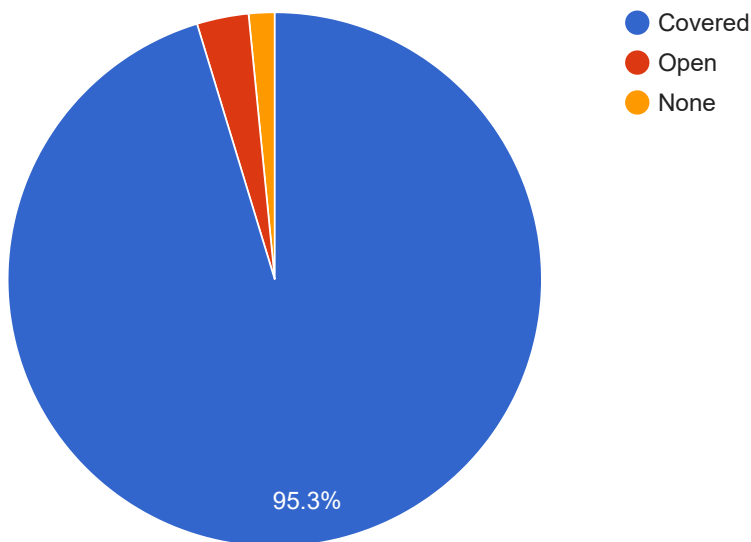

### Household Waste Collection System

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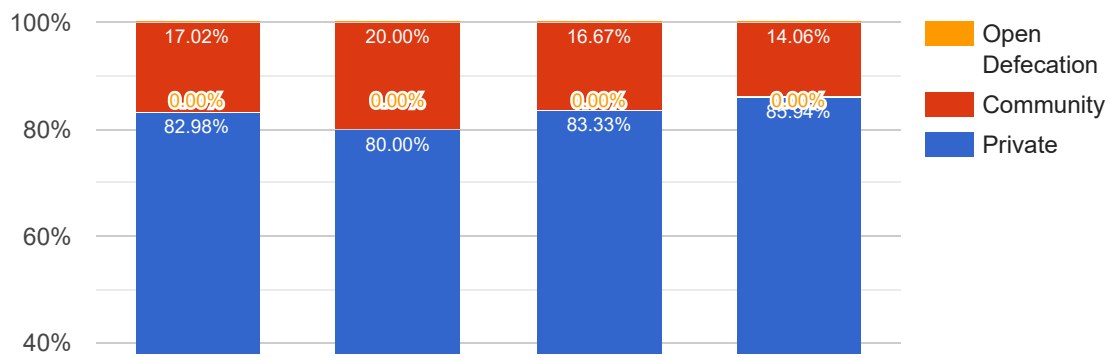

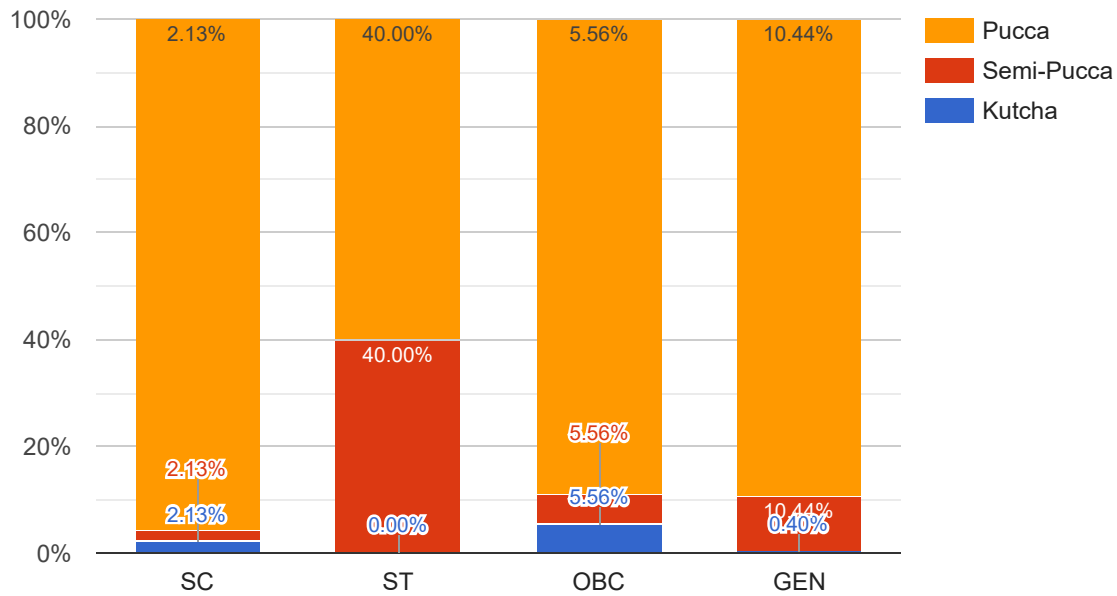

**Type of Houses among the households**

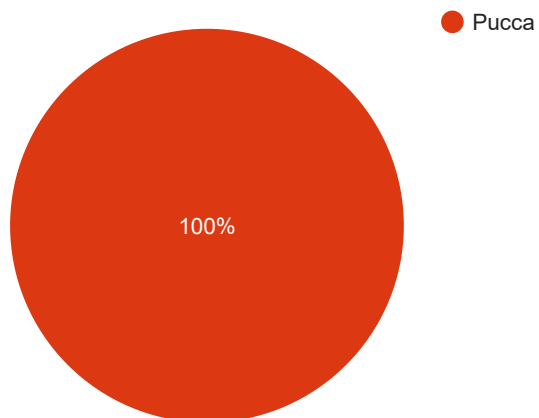

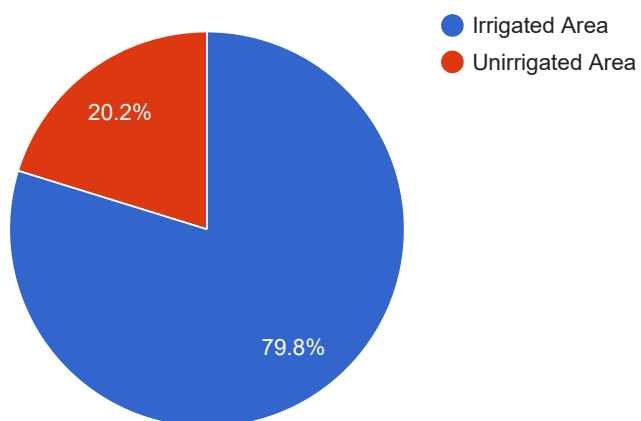

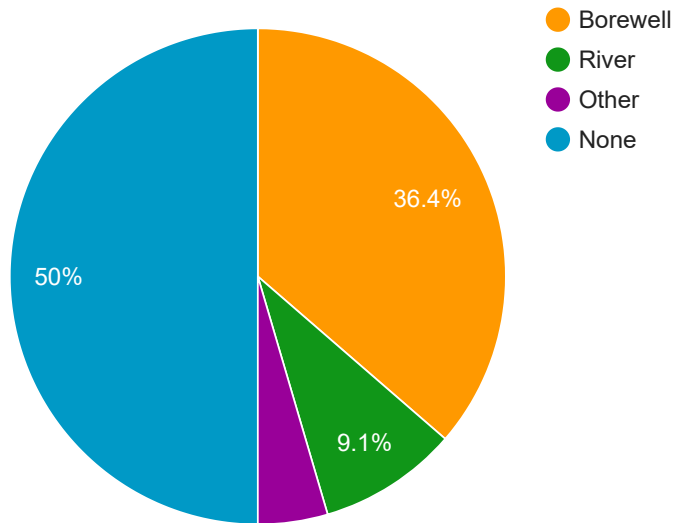

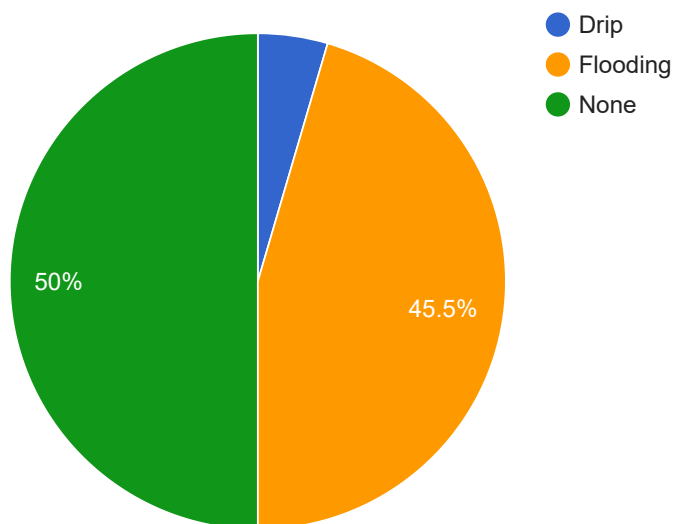

### Irrigation methods used among the households



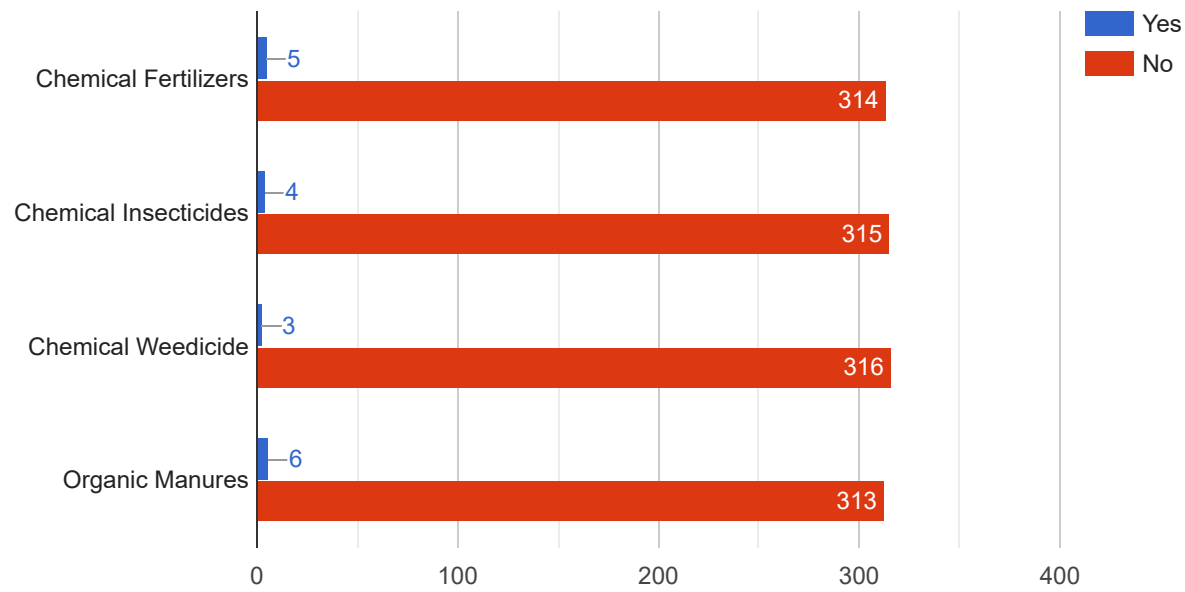

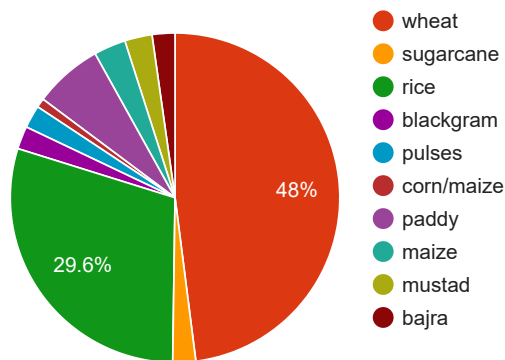

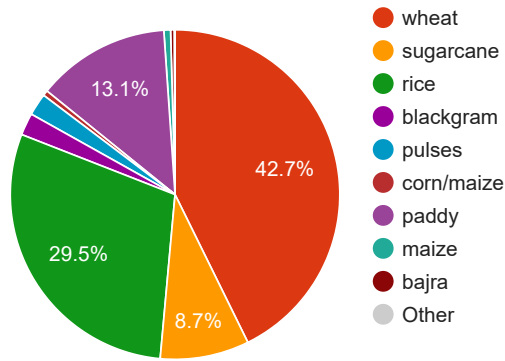

**Average Productivity per acre(in quintals) of major crops**

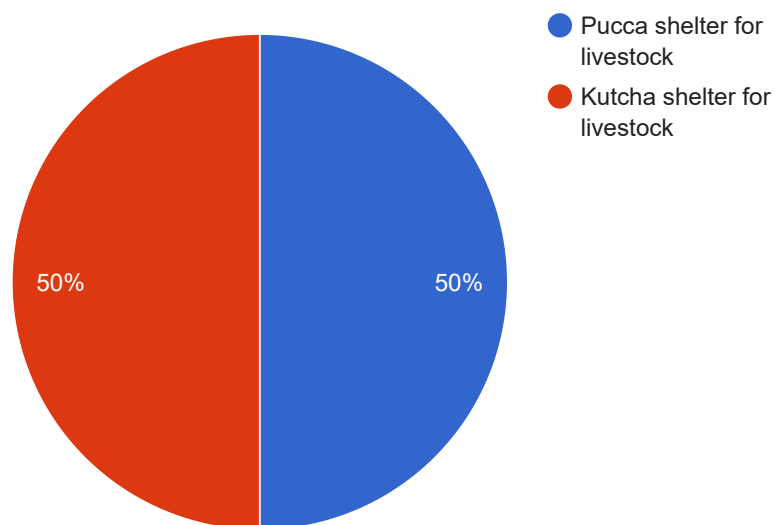

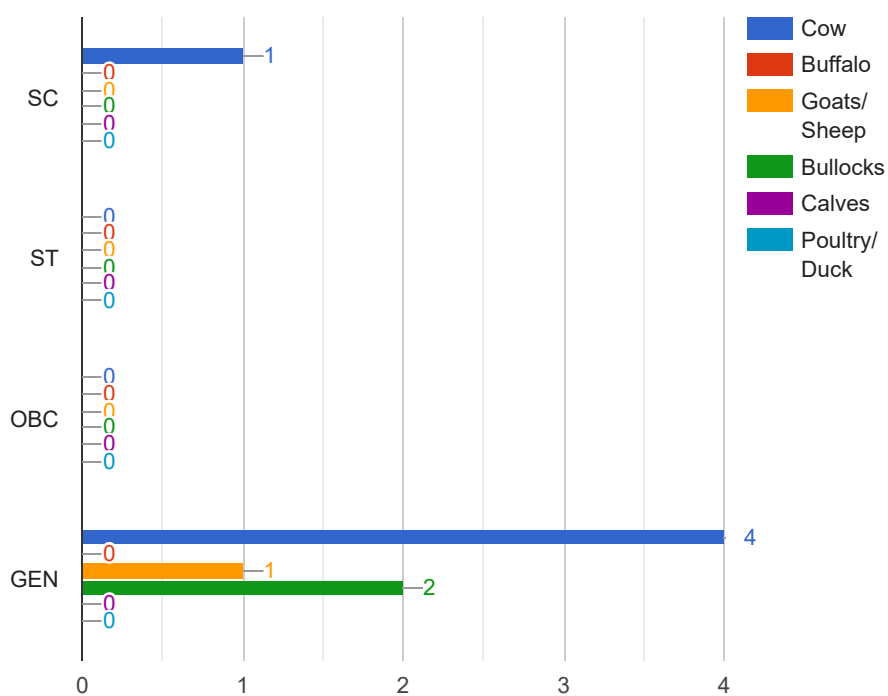

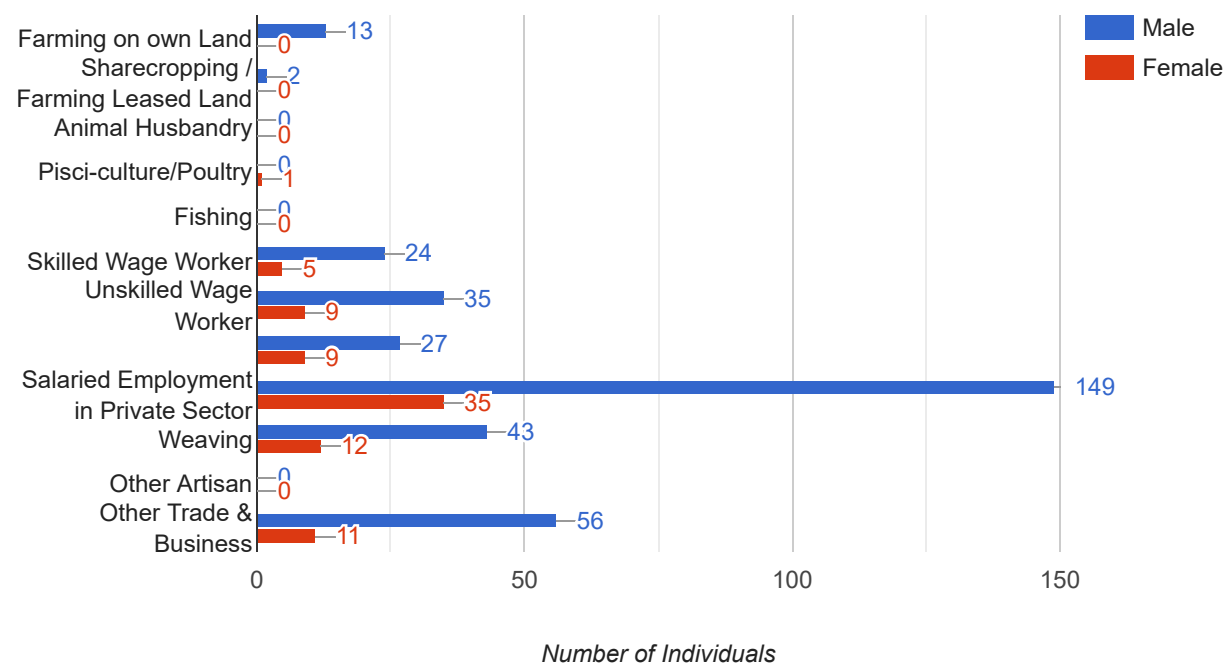

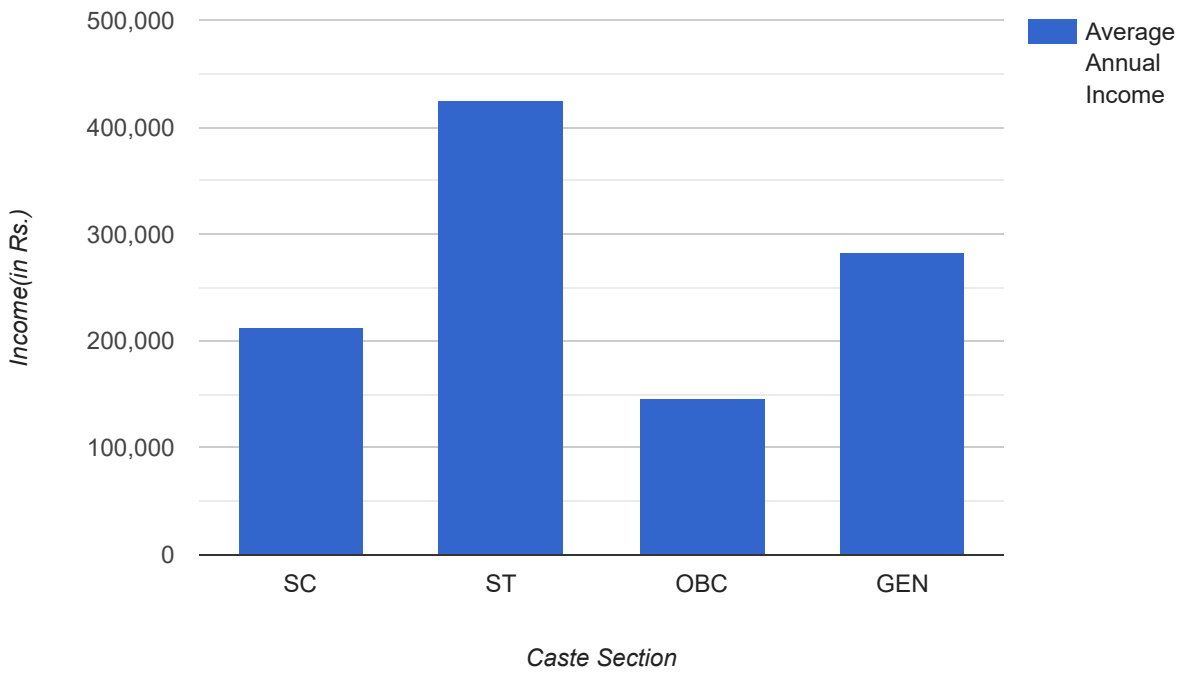
**Occupation Pattern**

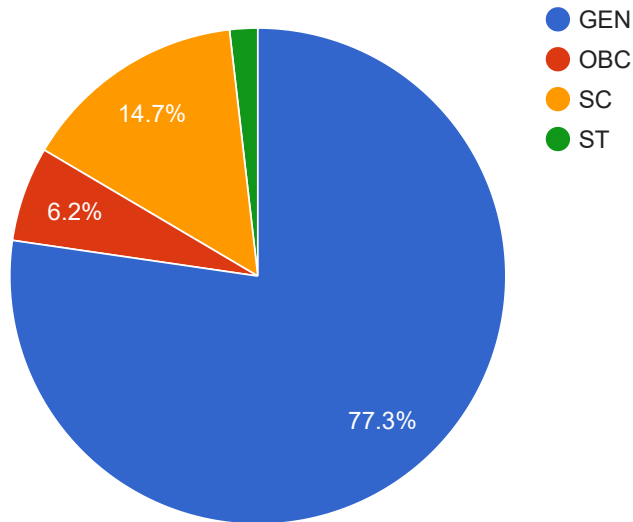

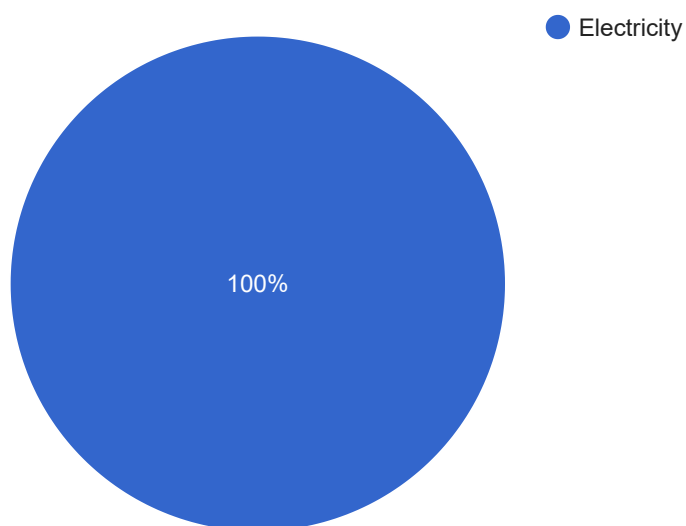

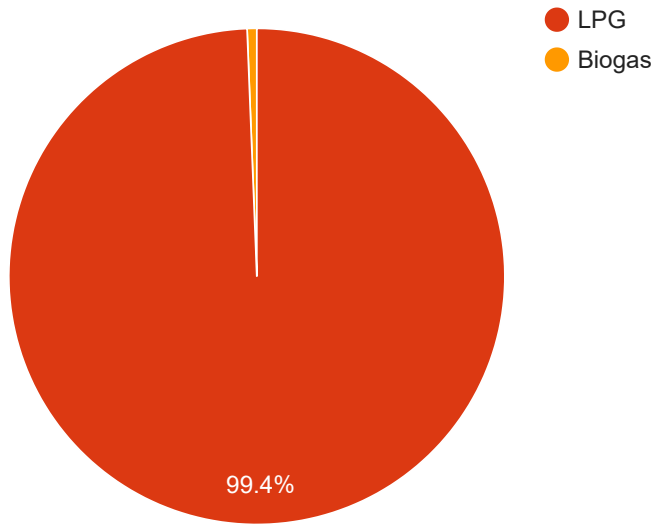
