Aims:

- Foster resource mobilization and capacity building to facilitate the production of high quality research to target outcomes like innovation, development of public policy, improved quality of life of the general population, economic prosperity and social welfare
- Encourage Student Research Projects in the departments
- Document and disseminate best practices for research promotion and encourage the observation of the highest standards of ethics in research input and output through plagiarism check.

Research Assistance Policy

Rs. 20,00,000/- (Rupees twenty lakh) has been allocated by DAV Managing Committee, Delhi as seed money to be spent on promotion of research in the college. The Research Promotion Cell has formulated the following policy to promote research amongst the faculty members as well as students of different departments:

• Provision of Duty leave up to three days per year for every staff member for the purpose of paper presentation in national/ international seminars, conferences, symposiums and workshops (within India)

- Reimbursement of Registration fees of up to Rs. 5000/- per financial year for paper presentation at National/ International Seminars, Conference, Symposium and Workshops (with in India)
- Reimbursement of Conveyance charges if two or more than two faculty members as well as the students go together for National/ International Seminar, Conference, Symposium and Workshop (with in India)
- Financial assistance for Student Research Projects under the guidance of faculty.
- Felicitation of faculty members whose papers get published in reputed/web indexed/CARE listed journals
- Financial Assistance to Faculty Members for getting Membership of Professional Bodies (thirty percent of the total fee amount not exceeding Rs. 2000/-)
- Financial support for publication of UGC Approved Journal of the college, NEW HORIZONS, and IQAC Newsletter
- Honorarium to the Resource Persons invited to the College
- Purchase of Plagiarism Software.
