The **Department conducted a preliminary round wherein56 students participated** and out of these, three students were selected for the finals. The college team comprising of Savi Arora of BA III Political Science Hons, Anamika of BA III and Reetika of BAII Political Science Honors won first prize.

To mark **Independence Day**, an **Intra College Poster Making Activity** was organized in the college on 16<sup>th</sup>August, 2018 on the following four themes:


- 1. A pictorial representation about the early events of the Indian National Movement such as the Revolt of 1857, Peasant and Tribal Uprisings such as the Indigo Revolt of 1859 and the Formation of Congress

- 3. Portray the Civil Disobedience Movement, Non- Cooperation Movement, Gurudwara Reform Movement Quit India Movement, Home Rule Movement, the making of national flag, framing of Indian Constitution etc.
- 4. Depict the achievements of the successive governments in India post- independence in various sectors such as rural, urban, education, health.

The students from various streams participated in the event which served as an opportunity for them to show their creativity and innovation. Dr. Nisha Bhargava, the Principal of the institution graced the occasion with her presence and encouraged the participants to work for the betterment of the country in the future and uphold the ideals propagated by our national leaders.



An event to pay **tribute to the late Prime Minister of the country Sh. Atal Bihari Vajpayee** was organized on 18<sup>th</sup>August, 2018. The students recited his composed poems and presented an audio- visual presentation on his life and political career. Various schemes started by him during his tenure such as Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan for free and compulsory education for children and introduction of new telecom policy that ended the hegemony of public enterprises in the industry were brought into light.

Principal, Dr.Bhargava addressed the audience and paid tribute to former Prime Minister by highlighting the achievements of the outstanding statesman.



In order to mark United Nations Day the Department organized **Intra College quiz** on 24th<sup>th</sup>October, 2018 on the theme **United Nations Organisation**. 94 students participated in the preliminary round and 8 students who secured highest marks were selected for the main round. The team comprising Mehar (B.A III) and Muskan Lamba (B.A I) grabbed the first position while Shagun and Apoorva of B.A Ist stood second, and Hashpreet and Mansi of B.A I got 3<sup>rd</sup> position.

The celebration included poster making and essay writing activity. The students participated enthusiastically in these activities depicting the day's themes in their posters and essays. Besides these a special issue of department wall magazine was also released carrying information pertaining to the historic day in the life of our nation.Dr. Bhargava motivated the students to cherish the provisions of the constitution and work towards upholding them.
