
Celebrating International Day for the Preservation of the Ozone Layer with fervour. the Department of Zoology organised an online National level Quiz Competition. Organised on the theme 'Ozone Depletion and Climate Change', the quiz witnessed enthusiastic participation of over 560 students from different states and UTs of the country including Punjab, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Delhi, Noida, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Karnataka, Assam and Chandigarh. With the aim of raising awareness among students about the importance of the ozone layer and the need to preserve it, the quiz consisted of MCQs, objective questions and image based questions to test the knowledge of participants pertaining to the ozone layer. The winners were awarded cash prizes and e-certificates were given to those who secured 75% and above.

A massive cleanliness drive was organised by the NSS Committee of the college wherein cleanliness related activities were undertaken throughout the campus. Extensive cleaning of the campus was undertaken which included following activities:

 Thorough brooming and cleaning of campus lawns, parking area, administrative buildings, library, staff rooms, hostels, Celebration Ground, Panghat Area etc.
Cleaning of the library.

3. Cleaning of classrooms, window panes and switch boards in all rooms.

4. Removal of unwanted weeds and shrubs around the periphery and in the campus.

5. Segregation of waste into biodegradable and nonbiodegradable (Both the wet waste and dry waste were collected at different places and later on wet waste was disposed of in the compost pits).

6. Thorough cleaning of dustbins and their proper placement at respective areas.

7. Cleaning and sanitization of washrooms with cleaning solutions.

8. Sanitization of door handles and handrails.

9. Thorough cleaning of aquatic pond situated in the college Botanical Garden and removal of weeds.

10. Cleaning and sanitization of laboratories.

11. The garden waste of the campus which is already being converted into nutrient enriched compost (through in-house compost pits) was used for gardening purpose.


