Horticulture Committee has been constantly involved in the beautification as well as in landscaping of the college campus. In the beginning of session, landscaping was done in the front lawn of the college campus where beautiful, eco-friendly soil plateau, withseveral aesthetic saplings was created. Keeping in mind the eco-friendly 'Swachh' approach, beautification with recycling material was done in the college central front lawn as well as in the parking areas. To enhance the aesthetic appeal of the campus, members of Horticulture committee has been constantly involved in procuring as well planting new seasonal flowering plants timely. Recently, the college participated in the annual Chrysanthemum show held at terrace garden in Chandigarh where many varieties of chrysanthemum were displayed. In order to maintain the serenity and aesthetic value of Rishi vatika, area around the entrance wasface-lifted and beautifully landscaped with 50 saplings of Ficussps. In a similar manner, botanical garden was upgraded with different seasonal floral species as well as with plants, which are required for curriculum. One of the main task done by the committee includes installation of vertical planters in front of Principal's office that not only maximized the area usage but also enhanced the visual appeal. Besides, botanical garden as well as Rishi Vartika has been resurrected with medicinal plants including Tulsi, Ashwagandha, Brahmi, Basil, Haldi as well as with different varieties of roses, Tagetes, Salvia, Pholex.
