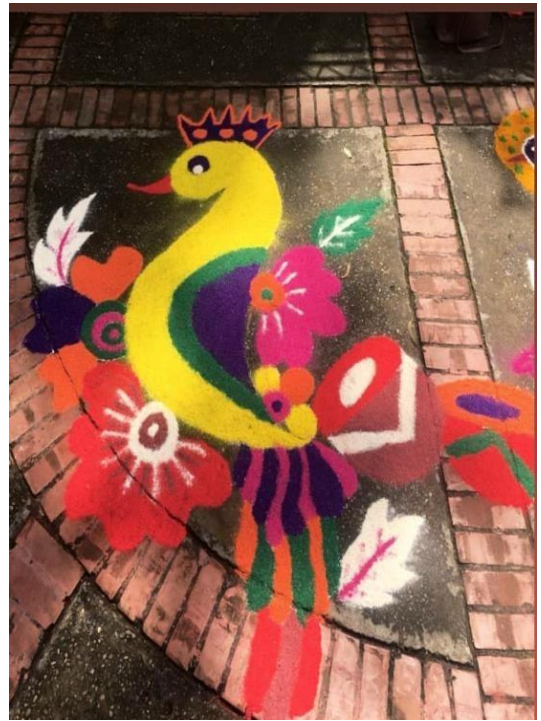
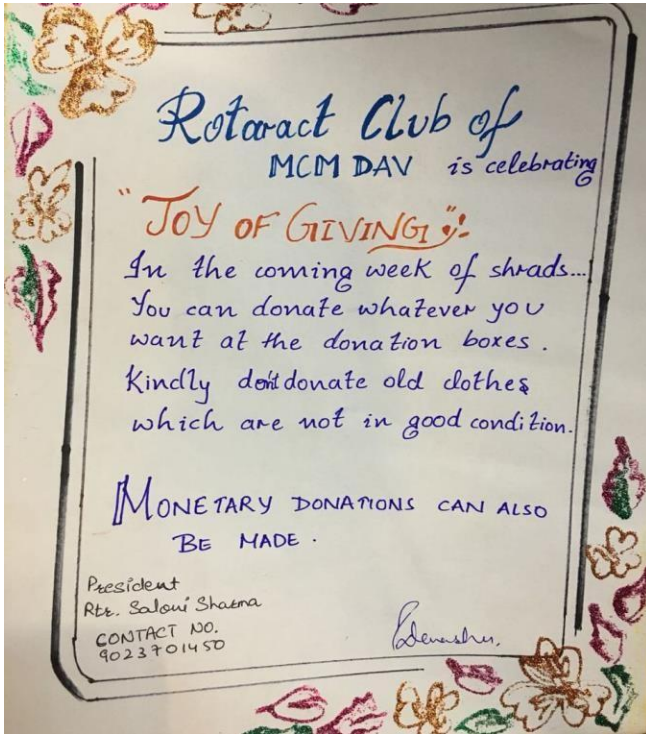
## **SAMARTH 2.0-**

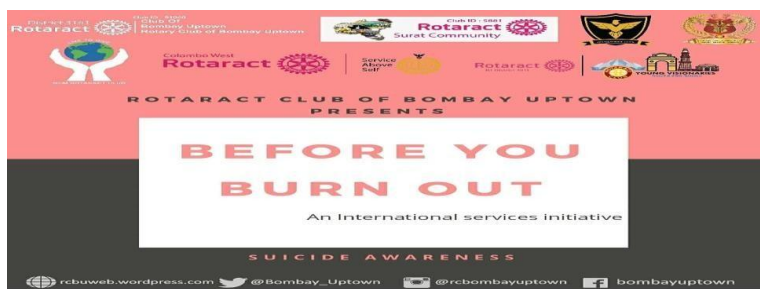
## RANGG-

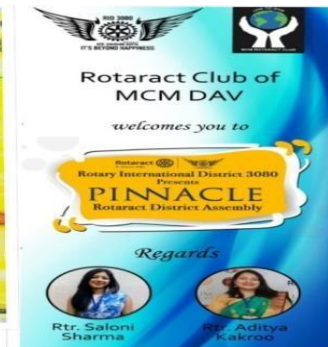
## RI PRESIDENT'S VISIT TO ELANTE-

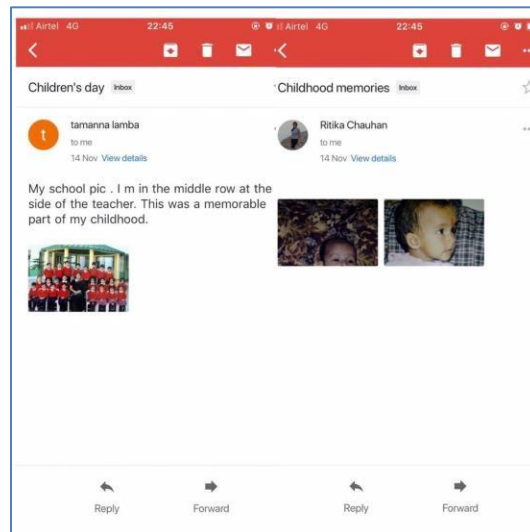




## GOLDEN DAYS OF CHILDHOOD-

Donation boxes were planted and put all across the campus for the collection of winter wear. These clothes will be distributed among the underprivileged people.





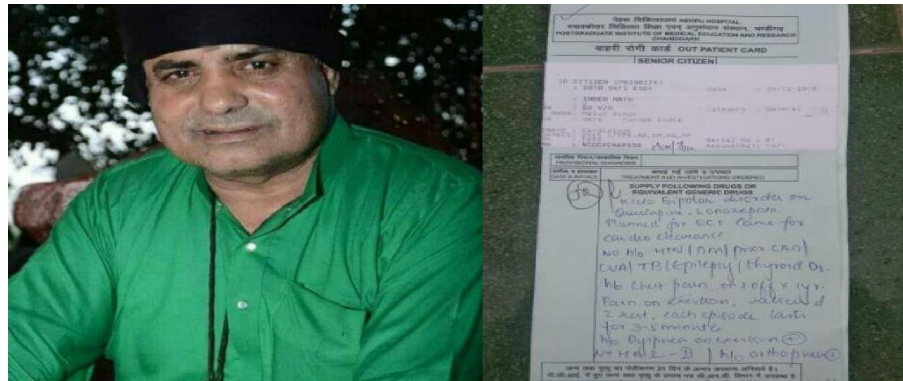
## SECRET SANTA-
