Report for the Session 2018-19

Meetings held:

The members of the UGC Committee held their periodic meetings on 10 September, 2018 to discuss and assign responsibilities for locating the details of various grants and schemes offered by different agencies and informing the faculty about them. Various other issues such as strengthening the Mentorship Programme, starting Skill-oriented Courses and holding Remedial classes for slow learners were also taken up.

On 21 May 2019, another meeting was held to Plan a Workshop for the faculty under the aegis of the IQAC.

Funding/Grants received:

- A Grant of Rs. 86,000/- was received from the Department of Science and Technology and Renewable Energy, Chandigarh Administration to conduct science-based activities for the popularization of science in the session 2018-19.
- Dr. Vandana Sharma bagged a Research Project worth Rs. 75,000/- from the
 Department of Science and Technology and Renewable Energy, Chandigarh
 Administration (S&T&RE/RP/147) on the topic "Biosensor based kit for Rapid
 Detection of Enterobacteriaceas in Drinking Water' in 2018. Her Co-investigator
 was Dr. Sandeep Kaur.
- The Department of Punjabi was sanctioned an amount of Rs. 80,000/- by Chandigarh Sahitya Akademi for conducting a National Multidisciplinary Seminar on 07 February 2019.

Event conducted: Innovative Pedagogical Techniques for Effective Classroom Teaching
