**Name of Activity: Rally and Nukkad Natak & Plastic Free Campaign under Swachhata Pakhwada 2020**

**January 29, 2020**

**Need of the Activity:**

This activity was undertaken by UBA cell of the College jointly with the NSS team of Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College falling under the ambit of Swachhata Pakhwada 2020 of Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College as per the guidelines of UGC. The objective of this activity was to create awareness amongst the residents of the village about the hazardous effects of the use of plastic. An earnest endeavor was undertaken to combat the rampant use of plastic bags in the daily chores of the villagers, both on a domestic and commercial front. An attempt was made to motivate the residents of the village to use cloth or paper bags instead of plastic bags.
