Name of Activity: Online Session on "Covid Vaccination: Myths and Reality"

Date of Activity: 18th June, 2021

Need of the Activity:

The Unnat Bharat Abhiyan wing of MCM DAV College for Women, Chandigarh conducted an online session on "Covid Vaccination: Myths and Reality". The prime objective of the session was to disseminate awareness regarding the myths associated with the administration of covid 19 vaccine jab. The prime objective was to clear the doubts of the people, address their queries and apprise them with factual information regarding the causes, symptoms and remedies available to combat covid 19. The Resource person to deliver the lecture was Dr. Sanjeev Mittal, a renowned cardiologist of the tricity. The special invitee at the webinar was Shri Hardeep Singh, Councillor of the three villages viz.Buterla, Badheri and Attawa .The organizers of the session were the village incharges viz. Dr. Arshdeep (village Buterla), Dr. Nidhi Tanwar (village Badheri) and Dr. Kanika(village Attawa) all Assistant Professors from the department of Commerce, MCM DAV College for Women, Chandigarh. Around 30 student volunteers of the UBA wing of the College, residents of the villages and teachers of Govt. school, Buterla participated in the session.

As a part of the Campaign celebrating '75th Bharat Amrit Mahotsav', the UBA team, led by the village incharges of Buterla, Badheri and Attawa and assisted UBA student volunteers of the College, conducted a one-hour online session on "Covid Vaccination: Myths and







The Resource person Dr. Sanjeev Mittal, a renowned cardiologist of the tricity, having to his credit 17 years of experience, gave a detailed visual explanation of the causes, symptoms and remedies of covid 19. He highlighted the application of risk and benefit approach to expedite the vaccination drive and attain synergetic effects. He addressed various queries of the participants regarding the myths and facts of covid vaccine with clinical data and information. The special invitee at the webinar was Shri Hardeep Singh, Councillor of the three villages viz. Buterla, Badheri and Attawa. Shri Hardeep Singh expressed the need to have a restoration of humanitarian deeds of kindness which have largely escaped the scenario reflecting post covid phase. Shri Hardeep Singh, in his spirit of altruism, suggested the organization of a covid vaccination camp in his villages. His recommendation was supported by Dr. Gunjan, Coordinator, UBA Cell of the college.

There were over 80 participants in the session including teachers of Govt. school, Buterla, residents of the villages, and student volunteers of the UBA Cell of the college. The session concluded on a satisfactory note with a recharged spirit to combat covid 19 by promoting vaccination drives along with a continued adherence to the three-pronged safety protocol.
