Faculty Publications / Awards / Achievements / Activities:

• There have been academic advancements by 3 faculty members who got their books published in diverse areas titled "Banking and Insurance Services' - Forth revised edition", "E-governance in 21st Century: Reinventing G2B Relationship" and "Working Capital Management Practices of Textile Industry in India". In addition, 3 faculty members had their chapters published in books during the session

- 3 faculty members had to their credit the publication of papers in UGC listed Journals such as **Horizon**, **Sambodhio**.
- There has been active participation of the faculty in terms of paper presentations, wherein 4 papers have been presented by them in various National and International Conferences/Seminars. The titles of the conferences were wide ranging such as "Reimagining Business focus on Customer", "IIF International Conference & Summit August 2020on Banking, Money & Crypto Markets", The Ecology of New Economy Post Covid-19 and Safety and Security of Women in the Contemporary World: Issues and Challenges.
- 5 faculty members were sanctioned a total of 3 undergraduate research projects amounting to Rs. 50,000 (approx.).
- Some Members of the Department are active members of important bodies such as PG Board of Studies, Institution's Innovation Council, Life Member (Punjab Commerce and Management Association) and Indian Red Cross Society.
- The department has been vigorously organizing Extension Lectures whereby 7 such Lectures titled "Research Methodology: Concepts and Applications", "Wealth Creation through Personal Finance Management", "ESG Investing and Mutual

Funds", to name a few, were conducted. Eminent resource persons from industry as well as academia including CA Sahil Gupta, CA Amitoz Singh, Prof. Tejinder Sharma, CA Shubham Pandey to name a few, apprised the students about the research projects, procedure of online filling of Income Tax return and provided valuable insights into the concept of responsible investing. Furthermore, **2 Skill-based Workshops**, namely, "**Basics of Income Tax Laws**" to make the students aware of the basics of Income Tax laws in India and "**Empirical Financial Econometrics using E-views**" to provide them hands on experience on E-views were also organised during the session.

- 11 students cleared National / State competitive examinations, such as UGC NET, during this session.
- Over 28 undergraduate as well as post graduate students participated in various Inter College competitions, such as Logo Designing, Caption Writing and Sell Well Competition held at SGGS College, Sector 26, Chandigarh and one of the students bagged 1 First Position in Logo Designing.
