



- 1912 departmental books and 605 donated books added to the library in the session 2020-21.
- Rs. 1, 91887/- were spent on periodicals and newspapers in the session 2020-21.
- Library is fully computerized with software i.e. Web Centric LSEase. Issue Return is done with Bar Code Scanner. Library has internet facility and **Web OPAC (Online Public Access Catalogue)** for students and staff.
- To develop reading habits among students "Best Library Reader" prize is given to two students. This year it goes to Danish Kaur of BA III (Roll No 2379) and Esha Jaiswal of MA II Sociology (Roll No 5656).
- Library ensures access to E-resources, databases, books to students through emails and telephonically on regular interval.
- Library has been shifted to a new spacious location on the ground floor, which is easily approachable as also being disabled friendly and fully air conditioned. It offers more seating capacity, separate sitting sections for students and staff.
