Objectives:

- To facilitate interaction of parents with teachers in online mode in the uncertain times of pandemic
- To provide a platform to parents to share their concerns regarding performance of their wards, online exams, hostel fee structure and resolve any other queries
- To acquaint the parents with the achievements of College in recent years

Practice: Owing to the pandemic situation, the PTA meet was held in online mode this year. The Online PTA Meet was organized in two sessions. The first meet on 11th February, 2021 was conducted for the parents of students from Commerce stream. The second meet on 12th February, 2021 was held for the parents of students from Science and Arts streams.

The meetings began with a formal welcome of parents and a brief introduction of the College and its achievements in the recent years. A detailed presentation of the guidelines pertaining to online Examination (February 2021) was also given. Principal Dr. Nisha Bhargava addressed the parents and reiterated the fact that the parents and teachers are together in the journey towards holistic development of the students. The parents then interacted with the respective teachers. To facilitate the interaction, various Heads of Departments and Heads of various Committees were available online and they handled the concerns of parents. Parents had queries relating to the performance of their wards which were directed to the concerned teachers. To meetings ended with a vote of thanks to the parents.

Outcome: Apart from a few queries relating to the scholarships, performance of their wards, the parents shared their concerns relating to the online exams and fee structure of the Hostel during the times of lockdown. All queries were suitably handled and numbers/emails of parents were noted down in case of specific queries. Replies were sent to these parents after the meet. Parents were also requested to fill up the feedback forms. Many parents attended the meet with enthusiasm and the online mode facilitated those parents to attend the meet who were out of station and are generally not able to attend the Parent Teacher Association Meets in the offline mode. Parents expressed their gratitude to the college and teachers for arranging the meetings despite the challenges.
