

The participants showed their interest by sharing their practice work along with the workshop and very positive feedbacks have been received from them as well. On the first day of the workshop, the demonstration of rose floral bunch was given on the fabric (pillow cover) followed by simple step by step instructions to paint. On the second day of workshop, the demonstration of white tulip floral bunch was given. Along with this, the painting was taught in a simpler manner for the beginners on paper sheets. On the third day, how to take measures for a kurti, designing it and use of stencils were shown on fabric. On the fourth day, saree designing with floral paint was taught as well as block printing.

On the fifth day, glass bottle painting and designing for the decoration purposes was demonstrated. On the sixth day, workshop was concluded by teaching Decoupage on bottles. There were interactions with the participants and some of the participants practiced along with the workshop and showed their efforts to learn the techniques which were being taught in the workshop. Overall it was a productive workshop and nice experience for participants and coordinators as well.
