
De. Vibba phase discuss in 10Ac meeting Parent Teacher Association Meet 2020-21

Parental Feedback analysis: The parents were requested to review the provision of the various programmes undertaken by the College. Their feedback was recorded into five categories i.e., Excellent, Very Good, Good, Average and Poor. A total of 108 feedback forms were received from the parents. The following were the outcomes:

- Parental Pride and Respect: All the parents felt satisfied. 56.5 per cent of the parents rated this as excellent, 39.8 per cent as very good, 2.8 per cent as good, and none felt that they were average, and 0.9 per cent as poor.
- <u>Discipline Practices</u>: 99.1 per cent parents felt satisfied. 51 per cent of the parents rated this as excellent, 40.7 per cent as very good, 7.4 per cent as good, 0.9 per cent as average, and none felt that they were poor.
- <u>Value Based Education</u>: All the parents felt satisfied. 44.5 per cent of the parents rated it as excellent, 43.5 per cent as very good, 12 per cent as good, and none felt that they were average or poor.
- Sports Activities: All the parents felt satisfied. 34 per cent of the parents rated these as excellent, 43 per cent as very good, 23 per cent as good, and none felt that they were average or poor.
- Extra-Curricular Activities-Debates, Drama, Music, Fine Arts: 96.3 per cent parents felt satisfied. 43.5 per cent of the parents rated this as excellent, 43.5 per cent as very good, 9.3 per cent as good, 3.7 per cent as average, and none felt that they were poor.
- Support Services like Bank, Canteen, Student Center, Career Counselling cell etc.: 98.1 per cent parents felt satisfied. 36.1 per cent of the parents rated these as excellent, 41.6 per cent as very good, 20.4 per cent as good, 1.9 per cent as average, and none felt that they were poor.
- <u>Infrastructure Facilities includes Library and Labs</u>: 99.1 per cent parents felt satisfied. 34.3 per cent of the parents rated this as excellent, 40.7 per cent as very good, 24.1 per cent as good, 0.9 per cent as average, and none felt that they were poor.
- Response to Community Needs Extension Programmes: 99.1 per cent parents felt satisfied. 33.3 per cent of the parents rated this as excellent, 46.3 per cent as very good, 19.5 per cent as good, 0.9 per cent as average, and none felt that they were poor.
- Encouragement provided to Students for participation in Academic Forums: 99.1 per cent parents felt satisfied. 54.7 per cent of the parents rated it as excellent, 33.3 per cent as very good, 11.1 per cent as good, 0.9 per cent as average, and none felt that they were poor.
- Competence and Commitment of Faculty: 99.1 per cent of the parents felt satisfied. 53.7 per cent of the parents rated it as excellent, 36.1 per cent as very good, 9.3 per cent as good, 0.9 as average, and none felt that they were poor.
- System of Monitoring Student's Progress: 96.3 per cent of the parents felt satisfied. 45.4 per cent of the parents rated the this as excellent, 42.6 per cent as very good, 8.3 per cent as good, 3.7 per cent as average, and none felt that they were poor.
- <u>Teaching-learning Environment</u>: 100 per cent parents felt satisfied. 47.2 per cent of the parents rated it as excellent, 43.5 per cent as very good, 9.3 per cent as good, and none felt that they were average or poor.
- <u>Provision of Career-Oriented Programmes</u>: 94.4 per cent parents were satisfied. 25 per cent rated these as excellent, 50.9 per cent as very good, 18.5 per cent as good, 5.6 per cent as average, and none felt that they were poor.
