



टी-20 वर्ल्ड कप मुकाबले में तानिया ने दो खिलाड़ी किए स्टंपआउट, दो कैच लपके

शहरकी युवा क्रिकेटर तानिया भाटिया ने आइसीसी वुमंस टी-20 वर्ल्डक्य में मेजबान ऑस्ट्रेलिया के खिलाफ सिडनी में खेले गए मैच में जीत में अहम भूमिका निभाई। तानिया ने इस मैच में विकेट के पीछे दो कैच पकड़े और दो खिलाडियों को स्टंप आउट किया। तानिया इससे पहले भी कई बड़े टूर्नामेंट में खुद को साबित कर चुकी हैं। तानिया ने वुमंस टी-20 विष्व क्य-2018 में एक मैच में तीन खिलाड़ियों को स्टंप करने वाली भारत की दूसरी विकेटकीपर हैं।

उनसे पहले सुलक्षणा नाइक ने वह उपलब्धि हासिल की थी। तानिया ने अब कुल 44 टी-20 मैच खेले हैं, इसमें उन्होंने 21 खिलाड़ियों को कैच आउट तो 44 खिलाड़ियों को स्टंप पीछे 14 खिलाड़ियों को कैच आउट आउट किया है। तानिया ने 15 वनडे और 8 खिलाड़ियों को स्टंप आउट मैच खेले हैं, जिसमें उन्होंने विकेट के किया है।

ही मैंने लड़की होने की वजह से उस गेंद भाटिया भी कई सालों तक लड़कों की टीम 🏻 को कभी धीमे से मारा। मैंने हमेशा लड़कों की तरहही क्रिकेट खेला है और यही मेरी मजबूती रही है। तानिया के कोच आरपी सिंह ने बताया कि उनके पास तानिया अकेली लड़की बी जो क्रिकेट की कोचिंग लेने आती थी। तानिया अन्छा खेलती थी लड़कियों की टीम नहीं होने की वजह से किया जाता था। टीम इंडिया को पहले मैच में वह शानदार जीत है. टीम इंडिया काफी संतुलित हैं और मुझे पूरी उम्मीद है कि टीम इस बार जरूर ट्रॉफी के साथ

The UBA Cell of Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women, Sector 36, Chandigarh, falling under the flagship program of Govt. of India, covers a cluster of five villages around the periphery of Chandigarh. The villages in the ambit are Attawa, Badheri, Buterla, Kajheri and Maloya. Various activities have been undertaken in these villages in the past one year, beginning with Household Survey in each village, followed by a bevy of developmental initiatives like Lectures on Health & Hygiene, Community Meetings with the Village Councillors, Cleanliness Drives and Workshops, Rallies, Demonstration of Skill related Opportunities. An environment sensitizing campaign viz. "Plastic Free Campaign", spanning over several weeks, was also conducted in all the villages, wherein along with the dissemination of the information regarding the disastrous effect of plastic; suggestions and practical demonstration of Cloth bags & Waste Disposal was given to the residents of the village. All these activities were taken in enthusiastically by the villagers, and follow-up of the activities is also ensured. The UBA Cell of the College is looking forward to more such collaborations as would take the villages, a step forward in the areas of upliftment.

- Mushroom Cultivation.
