Sustainable Urban Farming

The Sustainable Practices Committee, in collaboration with the NSS unit of the College, carried forward the three-year-old practice of teaching and learning of organic farming to take forward the POSHAN Abhiyan scheme of Government of India. A batch of 25 students of NSS was given a background of the need for chemical free food and everyone's contribution towards it. The girls were also apprised of the need for growing one's own food to some extent to fulfill nutritional needs. The girls sowed the seeds for winter crops. Palak, methi, etc. The girls were also apprised about the issues related to care of plants and use of chemical free fertilizers as also about managing insects in a natural way. Two workshops were held in February and March to apprise the girls about its spurs related to slow growth and related problems, including those faced by farmers.

A seven-day E-workshop on Elegant Attire: Basics of Fashion Designing from 29 June to 11 July, 2020 was organized with an objective to enhance the sense of personal styling as well as create awareness regarding taking up a career in the fastly- evolving and huge fashion industry The resource person, Ms. Heena Sharma, the founder of CRIO, a sustainable clothing brand and founder of Heena Style Studio, discussed various avenues like art director, technical assistant, marketing head, product development and merchandise planner in the world of fashion can be explored and pursued, besides of course being a fashion designer. The main highlight of the course was introduction to the concept of sustainable fashion to the students which is much needed in these times of environment crisis. How the use, type and style of fabric can be made sustainable was explained to the participants. 69 students of the college actively participated and inquired about the relevance of a formal degree and other styling tips.





Building Research Aptitude : 7 Days Online Faculty Development Program for Faculty of Maharashtra Colleges from 14th to 20th July, 2020.

To facilitate the development of scientific attitude and logical thinking among the faculty across regions and communities a faculty development program was conducted by the Sustainable Practices Committee. A total of 220 (Consisting Principals, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors and Research Scholars from all over Maharashtra) participants registered for theevent.

The key resource persons were; Dr. Gurvinder Kaur, Associate Professor, MCM DAV College for Women, Dr. Minakshi Rana, Assistant Professor, MCM DAV College for Women, and Dr. Neeraj Kumar, Deputy Librarian, Panjab University. Before initiating a study certain key aspects such as identification of the problem area, target population, sampling techniques, and issues of objectivity, reliability, and value neutrality should be pondered upon. Further, review of existing literature, finding research gaps with the significance of the topic to be studied are initial and basic steps to start with the writing of the research paper. It was explained that data is the basis of any research project and it is important to choose the appropriate tool and sources to collect the data because further analysis or inferences would be based on the information collected. The various tools of data collection such as interview schedule, questionnaire, observation, case study, Survey, and Focused Group discussion were explained. Citation Style and Plagiarism check. Few of the Free Plagiarism checking Software were told about. Further, how to avoid Plagiarism while writing articles was focused upon.



Bridge Course on "Learn Basics of English"

A seven-day Bridge Course on "Learn Basics of English" was conducted by the Post-graduate Department of English from the 18th to 24th of July, 2020. The Resource persons were Dr. Apara Sharma and Ms. Ruchika Singh (Assistant Professors from the Department of English). The objectives

were to; understand and apply the basic skills of English Language in day to day life, introduce basics of phonetics and pronunciation, understand the basic concepts of grammar which form the building blocks of any language and keep the students constructively engaged during the lockdown. 75 participants from all walks of life registered; students, professionals and homemakers who wanted to brush up the basic skills of English language. The modules covered rules relating to tenses, subject verb agreement, speaking skills, writing skills, listening skills and basic pronunciation. The sessions were followed by online tests and PowerPoint presentations of the respective topic were shared. The sessions were made interactive by permitting the participants to interact during the last fifteen minutes of each session. All the participants were given e-certificates.

Online Bridge Course - Human Immune System Explained

A seven-day online Bridge Course titled "The Human Immune System Explained" was organized by the Department of Food Science from 21 July 2020 to 26 July 2020 to apprise and train the students at fundamentals of the human immune system, its related advancements and techniques used with special reference to scenario of COVID-19. The course was specially designed to give conceptual clarity to undergraduate students on basics and advances in the field of immunology, vaccinology and disease management. A total of 85 participants registered for the course with active participation from different states of India (Punjab, West Bengal, Tamil Nadu, Goa and Maharashtra). The students were given complete insight into the subject through well designed and interactive lectures and presentations by resource persons; Prof. Vijay Prabha from Dept. of Microbiology, PU, Chandigarh, Dr. Jyoti, Senior Assistant Professor, Dr. H. S Institute of Dental Sciences and Hospital, PU, Dr. Vandana Sharma and Dr. Sandeep Kaur from the college. The students were constantly engaged and assessed through knowledge-based quiz assignments. In addition, an orientation lecture on the increasing scope and relevance of microbiology in the present COVID-19 scenario was also delivered to all the participants. The course concluded with a powerful session on vaccine development and recent breakthrough and technological advances in the field of immunology and the resource person motivated theparticipants to explore the prospects of immunological sciences.

Bridge Course "Advanced Course in English"

A 10 day Bridge Course "Advanced Course in English" was conducted by the Post Graduate Department of English from 26th July to 4th August, 2020 where in the Resource persons were Dr. Apara Sharma and Ms. Ruchika Singh (Assistant Professors from the Department of English). The objectives were to; understand and apply the rules of advanced grammar in English, prepare the participants to apply for a job right from writing a Resume to facing an interview and keep the students constructively engaged during the lockdown.

57 participants paid Rs. 500/- each. It covered topics like rules for transformation of sentences, narration, writing applications, writing Resume, facing interviews and other related skills. Participants who registered for the Course included women who wanted to upgrade their language skills and also wanted to prepare themselves to enter the professional world. Sessions included online lectures, tests and PowerPoint presentations based on the day's session.





Bridge Course for Beginners in Research

The Department of Sociology organized a Bridge Course in Research from 4 August to 18 August 2020. The course offered a development of understanding of basic concepts of research, writing a research proposal, data collection tools, statistical analysis of findings, and use of computers to facilitate research. The resource persons were Dr Minakshi Rana, Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology; Dr Neeraj Kumar, Deputy Librarian, Panjab University; Ms Pallavi Kapila, Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology; Ms Shabnam, Assistant Professor, Department of Sociology. The course covered the following topics: Understanding Research and Basic Concepts (Day 1-3), Making of Research Paper (Day 4-6), Tools of Data Collection and Analysis of Findings (Day 7-9) and Use of Computer Skills in Research (Day 10-15). 66 participants (Students, research scholars, faculty and professionals from all over India and one Research Scholar from Canada) attended the workshop.

The basic characteristics and assumptions of various statistical measures like measures of central tendency, measures of dispersion and coefficient of correlation that can be applied in data to arrive at conclusions were briefly explained to participants. Further, the use of MS Word, Excel and Powerpoint

in developing a research paper or writing a thesis was explained with the help of live demonstration. In a significant session on plagiarism check and citation style, various free online softwares like Citation Machine, Plagcheck were shared with the participants that can help in checking the percentage of copied text in the research paper. Further, with the help of online tools like Mendeley and Citation machine, the researcher can download the citation of the desired research work in the required format. An assessment consisting of multiple choice questions based on the taught topics was also taken to gauge the understanding of the topics among the participants. A recapitulation of all the topics covered in the bridge course was donein the concluding session.

Beyond Boundaries: Eight-week Translation Skill Course with National Translation Mission, Government of India

The college conducted an 8-week online translation course from 17th of August, 2020 to 9th of October,

2020- 'Beyond Boundaries: Creating a World of Understanding' in collaboration with the National Translation Mission (NTM), Centre for Indian Languages, Ministry of Education, Government of India. Organized under the aegis of the Skill Development Committee of the college, the course catered to the flourishing multilingual world of literature, cinema, theater. anchoring, print and socialmedia. The course was in sync with the institution's vision of creating employment avenues through skill development and it also incorporated the ethos of the New Education Policy 2020 that emphasizes teaching and learning of Indian languages to be integrated with school and higher education at every level. Prof. Tariq Khan. Head. National Translation Mission, underlined the need for such courses and their growing significance



in the present scenario. The course was navigated by eminent resource persons from the practical and theoretical field of translation, namely; Prof. Rana Nayar- Theories and Role of Translation and Practical Sessions, Prof. Sudhir Kumar Mishra- Encoding and Decoding in Translation, Dr. Neeru Chugh -Genres of Translation, Gathering Background Information, Mr. Tariq Khan- Role of Government in Promotion of Translation, Mr. Winston Cruz- Machine Translation: Desktop Editing and Proofreading, Dr. Suman Sharma- History of Translation :India and Abroad and Legal Documents" Translation, Dr. Priya Padhye- Translation in Media and Entertainment, Dr. Pooja Malik- Machine Translation : Application and Challenges, Ms. Akanksha Bansal- Freelancing in Translation, Mr.

Biswadip Gogoi- Copyright Issues in Translation, Dr. Manjinder Kaur Wratch- Translating Fiction on

70 participants from across the country, ranging from Jammu to Tamil Nadu and Goa to West Bengal, benefitted from the course. The participants were also awarded certificates. The workshop gave the



students hands-on- training in translation as they were made to translate certain texts and the same were evaluated by the resource persons.

5-Day Series on Data Analysis

Quality research can contribute significantly towards the development of a nation through various

inventions and innovations. Considering the present scenario where the human kind is facing new challenges often, relevant and practical research has become more significant to find feasible solutions. Keeping that in mind, a 5-day Series on Data Analysis was organized by the Post Graduate Department of Sociology from 27 August to 31 August 2020. 47 participants attended the same. The wide range of the topics included Identifying Variables, Formulation of Hypothesis, Parametric and Non-parametric tests, Analysis of Qualitative Data and Use of Mendeley Software, aimed to provide knowledge about various statistical as well as nonstatistical tools to analyze and interpret data so that valid generalizations can be drawn.



Workshop on "Be a GST Expert": (Skill Development Committee under the aegis of Ministry of Skill development and Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India)

In order to develop expertise in the registration and filing of GST Returns, **a seven-day workshop** "**Be a GST Expert**" was organized from 12 to 18 September, 2020 by the institution in the capacity of a Registered training Centre of National Skill Development Centre of India, under the aegis of Ministry of Skill development and Entrepreneurship, Govt. of India, affiliated to Chandigarh Skill Development Mission. It helped over 50 participants to handle the individual projects of GST returns and registration. CMA Bhawna Sharma was the resource person who took examples from daily life and familiarised the participants with the various norms and guidelines of GST. In the era of the job crisis, this practical training could open new avenues of skill and work for the youth and make them self-reliant in the case of pursuing their own business. Further, with the help of live demonstration, the participants regarding compliance with the various provisions of GST were also taken up in the sessions.

Postgraduate The Department of Sociology and Charitra Nirman Committee of Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women online organised an online organised an online workshop cum awareness programme titled 'Critical Citizenship- Earning and Learning Sensibly'. The programme endeavoured to enlighten the audience about global perspectives on the emerging fields in an environment where earning, learning and better living can be pursued with due respect to nature. More than 400 professionals, scholars and educators, research and



students from all over India and from different countries including Jordan, Philippines, Pakistan, Ghana, Bangladesh and Srilanka registered for the programme. The resource person for this highly enlightening programme was Prof. Vinod Chaudhary, Department of

Sociology, Panjab University. Inaugurating the programme, Principal Dr. Nisha Bhargava highlighted its significance by saying that the theme of critical citizenship has profound contemporary relevance as the present lifestyles have bypassed sustainable development

wherein there is mindless plunder of natural resources without bothering about their conservation and rejuvenation. She expressed hope that this contextual initiative will definitely aid in sensitising human beings sensitising human beings about living responsibly. Prof. Vinod stressed on the importance of critical citizenship in critically assessing social, political and in economic structures to seek out and address areas of injustice, and implored the citizens to act to solve the root causes. The expert encouraged the participants to develop an amalgam of civic sense and scientific aptitude.

A Workshop cum awareness programme "Be a Health Manager"

A seven-day workshop cum awareness programme "Be a Health Manager" with an aim to promote holistic health and wellness was organized from 8 May to 14 May, 2021 under the aegis of Skill Development Committee. With 1835 online registrations from almost all states of India and professionals, faculty members and students from Estonia, Australia, USA Bangladesh, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Nigeria, Switzerland, Philippines, Jordan, Ghana and Oman, in coordination with experts from PGIMER Chandigarh, the wonderful workshop received huge participation on the virtual platform. The workshop which was comprehensively spread over seven days delved in detail into multiple topics which need attention and awareness.

Day 1: Preventive Eye Care

Dr. Parul Chawla Gupta, Assistant Professor at the Advanced Eye Centre at PGIMER, talked about how 60% of the people suffer from the digital eye strain, eye fatigue, headaches, itchy eyes, and blurring of vision lead to computer vision syndrome. Adults and children alike havedry eyes. She suggests the 20-20-20 rule which signifies: while working take a 20 seconds break, look at something 20ft far, every 20 minutes. For those having a hectic schedule, a software is available called "PAUSE" which notifies the user to take breaks. The interactive session ended with queries regarding undergoing any kind of eye surgery during the pandemic as well as dietfor improving vision.

Day 2: Understanding PCOS Symptoms and Treatment

The session conducted by Dr. Nirja Chawla, MD, covered all the aspects of PCOS (PolyCystic Ovary Syndrome) and its symptoms followed by treatments. It can be found in about 60% of the teenage girls having symptoms and signs such as delayed or irregular menstruation, obesity, androgen excess and infertility. About delayed ovulation she stated "excess of everything is bad", be it eating, fasting, exercising, not exercising, weight gain or weight loss. Other reasons can include pregnancy, stress or hormonal imbalance. The session was a detailed study of female hormones and the changes going on in the female body. Participants talked their hearts out and sought guidance from the expert.

Day 3: Hair and Skin Care

Starting the session with some general hair and skin care tips, Dr. Raihan Ashraf, Senior Resident with Department of Dermatology, Venereology and Leprology at PGIMER, suggested a balanced diet with lots of fluid intake. Basic skin and hair care routines were shared. She discouraged excessive use of chemicals on hair and skin. She addressed queries regarding oiling of hair and implied that choosing your products wisely was the key to getting nourished hair. Participants" worries regarding sunscreens even on cloudy days, dandruffs, acne, skin pigmentation etc., were also put to rest in the interactive session.

Day 4: Balanced diet to maintain right weight

Dr. Nancy Sahni, Senior Dietician at PGIMER and an executive member of the Nutritional Society of India, provided all the information regarding all groups of foods. Metabolism, healthy gut and a cut on the calories was what she focused on. Major take-away from the seminar was that before taking things off the shelf, one should properly examine the contents of the food package and mindful eating. Questions asked included worries regarding excessive weight and also underweight conditions. Diets were suggested for diabetic, PCOS patients and even for women in their post pregnancy phase.

Day 5: Oral Health Care

The session gave an insight to our participants on the oral health one should maintain by Dr. Ashima Goyal, Professor at Oral Health Sciences Centre, PGIMER. She talked about what happens when we develop habits that are in no way healthy for our teeth. She reiterated that all new trends, including the consumption of herbal hookahs etc, in no way are healthier or tobacco free. She suggested a proper routine to be followed for oral care. Queries regarding maintaining the whiteness of their teeth were clarified to a great extent. Strengthening of the teeth, bleeding gums etc were some of the many questions asked during the session.

Day 6: Understanding Food through Growing it: Towards Holistic Health

Dr. Gurvinder Kaur, Associate Professor in the Department of Public Administration in our college, delivered an informative session on Sustainable Urban Farming. As the name suggests, she explained how farming can be made sustainable even in the smallest corners of the houses.

She instilled the idea of going organic into the participants. She talked in great detail about all the processes and factors involved in the growth of plants. She mentioned beautifully how gardening helps maintain a healthy heart, builds confidence, reduces stress, anger, fatigue, depression and anxiety. She talked about the microgreens and plants used as air purifiers. Dr. Gurvinder Kaur filled everyone with so much enthusiasm that people literally started asking whether there are any online courses available for it. It was indeed an insightful and an inspiring session.

Day 7: Hints for Holistic Well-being

Physical, mental, social, emotional and spiritual wellness together contribute to holistic wellness, as explained by our last day's speaker, respected madam principal of our college, Dr. Nisha Bhargava. The session was built on providing tips for "striking a balance". She recited her poeticand meaningful compositions which made relevance of the topic more effective. The last day of the workshop was about how the last 6 days" teachings can be put together, their interrelation and interdependence. Dr. Nisha Bhargava concluded the workshop in a beautiful manner and motivated people to recognize the divine intervention that lies within them. She mentioned that dreams inspire us, so we should keep trying to achieve our dreams. She gave a mantra "multiply happiness by sharing virtues of contentment and joy". With the befitting conclusion of this session, the workshop also successfully culminated. The workshop was a resounding success, and 660 participants gave excellent feedback. The participants were heartily grateful to the organizers for such an engaging, enlightening and much-needed session that drew attention towards health and care.
