In pursuance of its significant judgment dated 8 May 2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009 which was notified by UGC as 'Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009' and subsequent communications received from the Ministry of Human Resource and Development from time to time, relevant steps were to curb, prevent and eliminate the menace of ragging.

Significant steps taken during the session in this direction include:

#### **Existence of Anti-ragging Cell:**

The Anti-ragging Cell/Committee of the college was expanded to control and prevent the incidents of ragging in the college, if any. It includes the following members:

#### **Information on Institutional Website**:

To curb the menace of ragging in college the following documents were uploaded on the institutional website for the information of the students and their parents:

- The statutory warning, UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in the Higher Educational Institutions, 2009 (dated: 17 June 2009)

#### **Anti-ragging Warning in the Institutional Prospectus:**

The statutory warning against Ragging was printed boldly in colour in both, the Prospectus of the College and Hostel (Online and Offline) for the information of students as well as their parents.



# RAGGING IS STRICTLY BANNED PUNISHABLE BY LAW

It has been impressed upon by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India that RAGGING is a criminal offence as per law.

#### What is Ragging?

Any act resulting in:

- Mental/Physical abuse.
- Verbal abuse.
- Indecent behaviour.
- Criminal intimidation.
- Wrongful restraint.
- Undermining human dignity.
- Financial exploitation/Extortion.
- . Use of force.

#### A student indulging in ragging can be:

- \* Expelled from the institution.
- \* Banned from the mess/hostel.
- Her Scholarship can be withdrawn.
- Debarred from examinations.
- Denied admission to any institution.
- \* Prosecuted for criminal action.
- Institutions have been asked to file FIR with local police against those who RAG / ABET ragging.

If the residents indulge in RAGGING or related activities then it should be immediately reported to the Warden/Principal

#### **Installation of CCTV Cameras:**

CCTV Cameras were installed at vital spots in the campus and hostel to keep a check on the activities of the students in the college premises. The monitor installed in the principal's office also helps to maintain a round-the-clock vigilance on any kind of unlawful activity by the students.

More CCTV cameras were installed at vantage points in the hostel premises to ensure the safety of students.

#### **Anti-ragging Undertaking**

As per the instructions of the government, Anti-ragging Undertakings were sought from all students at the time of admission. The submission of the document ensures the students' commitment of compliance with the government's policy of eradicating ragging.

Students were also asked to fill Online Anti-Ragging Undertaking at the National Portal of UGC and GOI (<a href="www.amti-ragging.in">www.amanmovement.org</a>) while filling up the online admission form of the college.

UGC Guidelines on the Menace of Ragging and a Sample of Anti-ragging Undertaking Form was made available on the College Website for the facility of the students

#### Introduction of the freshers with the Committee:

During the Induction/Orientation Programme held in the online mode during the Covid-19 Pandemic, the Convener and members of the Anti-ragging Cell were introduced to the new students. The senior students introduced them to the mandatory rules and regulations meant to prevent ragging. This was done through creative posters, innovative songs and meaningful skits presented online.

In her address to the student, the Principal of the college also sensitized the students about the evil of ragging.

#### **Events to Promote Awareness:**

- 1. A letter in the form of an e-mail was sent to the parents of all the students of BA II and BA III before the beginning of the session to sensitize them both regarding the evil of ragging.
- 2. Anti-Ragging Posters prescribed by the UGC as well as those made by the students were displayed at prominent places in the Campus and hostel to sensitize the students against the evil of Ragging.





1. Orientation Programme on Anti-Ragging: The Anti-Ragging Committee and the Hostel Committee organized an Orientation Programme for the new residents of the hostel on 25 September, 2021 in which Principal Dr. Nisha Bhargava introduced the students to the rich heritage of the institution and exhorted them to strive for excellence and maintain a ragging free campus. The students were also sensitized about the various forms of ragging and the mandatory regulations of UGC to control the menace of ragging in colleges. Dr Baljeet Kaur, Dean and Dr Jasmine Anand, Member, Hostel Committee also interacted with the students and announced the date for the formation of the Anti-Ragging Squad in the college. 104 students participated in the event.


#### 2. Awareness Programme for Students: on 19 October, 2021:


**3. Formation of Anti-Ragging Squad:** To maintain a Ragging-free campus, the members of the Anti-Ragging Committee formed an Anti-Ragging Squad of the students in which students of various classes volunteered to act as ambassadors of good conduct and prevent any incident of ragging or bullying in the campus as well as hostel. A total of 17 students belonging to diverse streams and disciplines were inducted in the squad on 8 April, 22.



#### 4. Sensitization Programme for NSS Volunteers:

A Sensitization Programme on Anti-Ragging was organized by NSS Units in collaboration with the Anti-Ragging Cell of the college on Day 5 of Seven Day/Night NSS Special Camp – 2022. The session started with a heart-touching poem based on a ragging incident recited by NSS Volunteer - Ms. Anjali.

During the session, Dr. Bindu Sharma defined Ragging as stated by the Honourable Supreme Court of India. She discussed a few cases of ragging that including Aman Kachroo Ragging Case in India that resulted in death, after which the Supreme Court of India intervened and took strict actions to stop more such incidents.



The Resource Person also informed the volunteers about the constitution of the college anti-ragging committee and motivated them to join her in the fight against ragging, and spread the word to others regarding the same. In the end, she gave blessings to all volunteers for their bright future.

Due to all these measures, no case of ragging was reported the session 2021-22.
