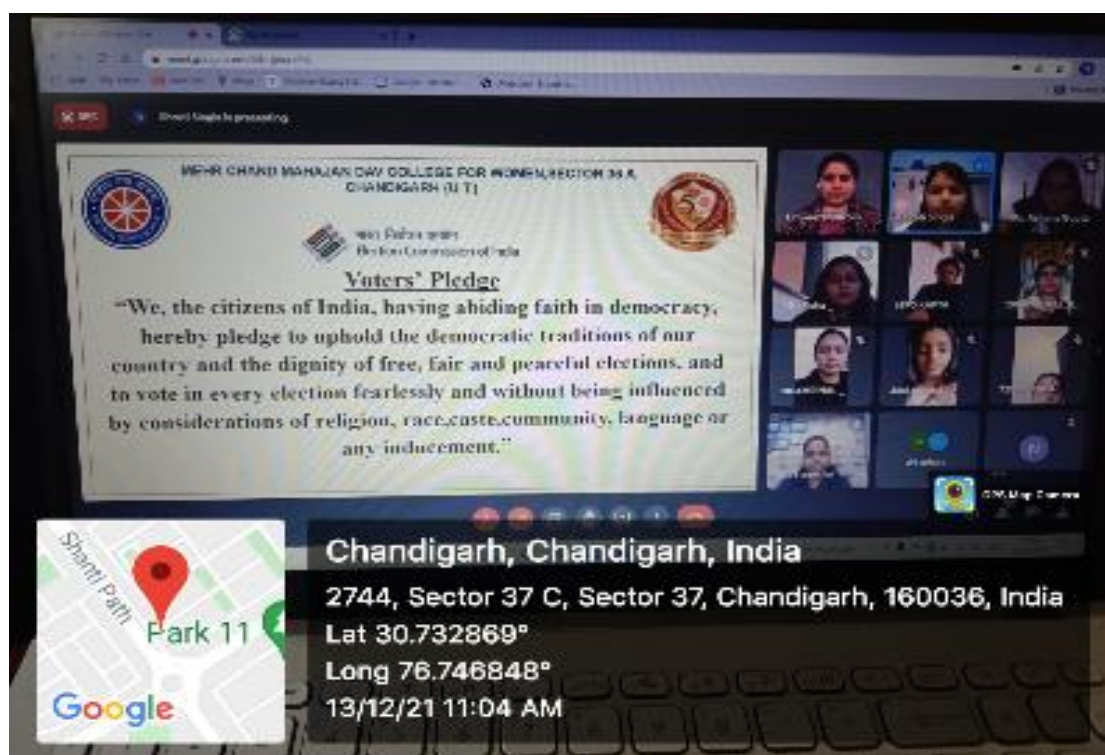
As per the instructions from the Chief Electoral Officer Chandigarh, the Electoral Literacy Club of the college initiated a drive of downloading the Voter Helpline Application on mobile phones on 2nd November 2021. 142 students and staff members of the college downloaded Voter Helpline Mobile Application and registered for the same.

The Club organized a One Day Camp for the newly eligible voters (residents of Chandigarh) to enrol themselves as voters on 15th November 2021. Students were guided to register as a voter on Voter Helpline App and their reference numbers were collected. 147 newly eligible voters filled the form in online/ offline mode.

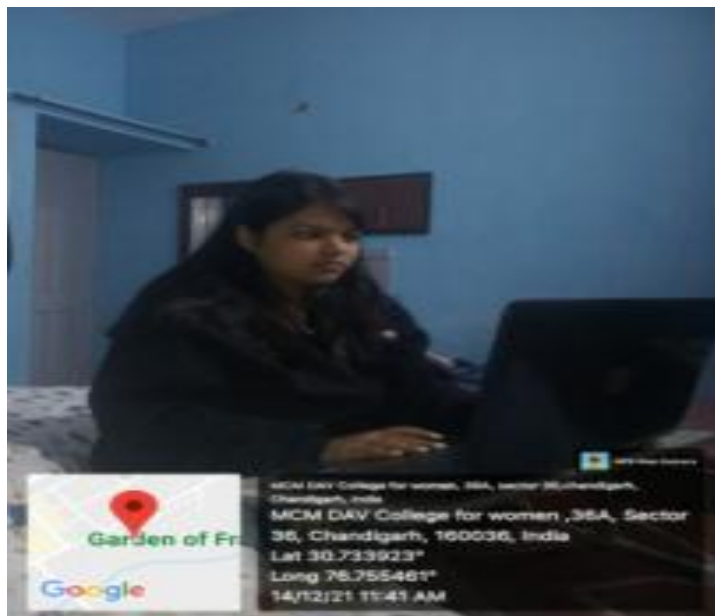




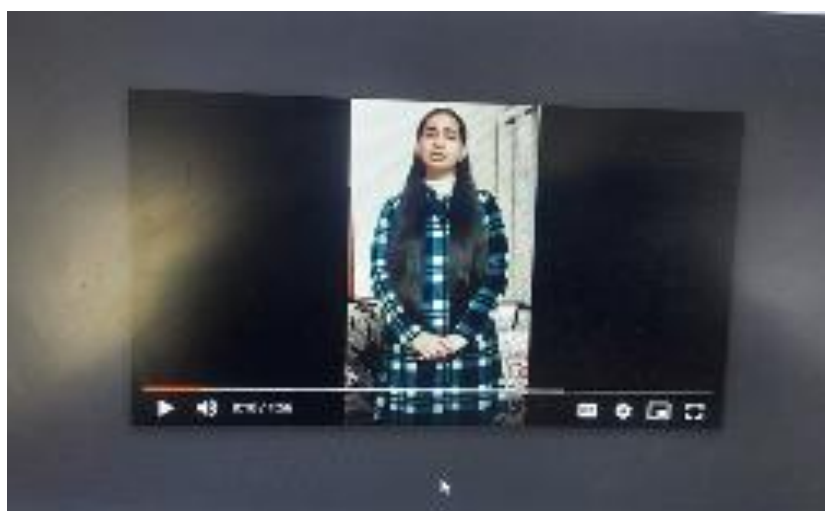

The online Electoral pledge was administered to create awareness regarding the electoral process on 13th December 2021. Here, the volunteers administered the voter's pledge wherein they vowed to 'uphold the democratic traditions of our country and the dignity of a free and fair process of elections and to vote in every election fearlessly and without being influenced by considerations of religion, race, caste, community, language or any inducement.'



The Club in association with NSS Units organized an online quiz on the topic 'Elections and Electoral Process in India' on 14th December 2021. 161 students participated in the competition. The first position was bagged by **Muskaan** (9826) of B.Com 2nd year. **Purnima** (1705) of B.A.1st year and **Ridhi** (8130) of B.A 3rd year won second and third positions respectively.



The Club in association with NSS Units organized a declamation contest on 'Importance of Local Bodies Election (Municipal Corporation - 2021) in Chandigarh'. The contest created the much-needed awareness amongst the first-time voters to vote for and support the right candidates in the Municipal Corporation Elections scheduled in December, 2021. 35 entries were received for the Declamation contest. Dhriti (B.Com II), Kashish (B.Com II) and Avnika (B.A. II) won the First, Second and Third prize respectively. Siya (B.A.III) and Gurpreet (B.A. I) were given the consolation prizes.

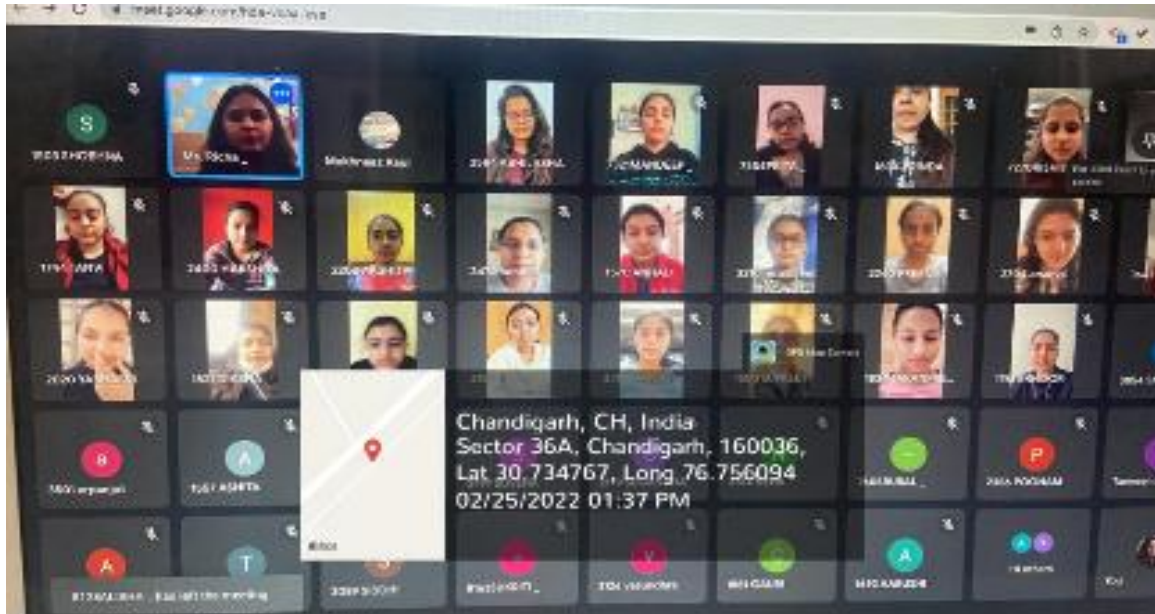
