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## 1. Career options in Sociology

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## 3. Pro-active safety programme

The post graduate Department of Sociology initiated a **Pro-active safety programme** in collaboration with Chandigarh Police on 11 August, 2018. The aim of the programme was to 'empower the girls we love' with self-defense skills that enables them to respond effectively to potential safety threatening situations. The inaugural of the programme was graced by Chandigarh SSP Nilambari Jagadale and DSP Anjitha, women and child support unit Chandigarh. The SWAYAM self-defense team demonstrated the self-defense techniques and conducted training sessions for the students in 15 batches, each batch comprising 100 students was imparted six days' training. The programme empowered 1500 girls with self-defense techniques.



### 4. Grand Finale of Pro-active safety programme

On 16<sup>th</sup> November, 2018, the **Grand Finale** of this programme was held. Honorable Punjab Governor and Chandigarh administrator Sri V. P. Singh Badnore graced the event as the chief guest. The other dignitaries present on this occasion included Chandigarh DGP Sanjay Beniwal, Chandigarh SSP Nilambari Jagadale, DSP Anjitha and SSP Traffic Shashank Anand. A Demonstration of self-defense tactics learnt during the programme was presented by 500 students, which drew a thunderous applaud from the audience.



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## 5. Visited radio station 98.3 FM

On 1<sup>st</sup> November 2018, the students of post graduate classes visited radio station 98.3 FM Radio Mirchi. Around 40 students were a part of this visit which aimed at providing the students the exposure and understanding of media operations. The students interacted with the Radio Jockeys, the producer manager Ms. Prerna and the Sound manager Mr. Sushant regarding various procedures associated with radio broadcasting.



## 6. Lecture on Glass Ceiling

The Women Development Cell of MCM DAV College for Women organised a lecture on 6<sup>th</sup> feb 2019 'Glass Ceiling' with the aim of empowering the students with requisite knowledge to overcome the socially constructed barriers that lead to inequality in the society. ## 8 UGC NET Workshop
