Brainstorming Session of NISP on 14/10/2020

Under the aegis of MHRD's Innovation Cell, Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women, Chandigarh organized the first brainstorming session with the selected experts of the committee 'National Innovation and Start-up Policy (NISP)' formed at HEI level. Various experts from different fields including Prof. Suresh K. Chadha, (Professor & Chairman University Business School, Panjab University, Chandigarh), Dr. Amandeep Singh Marwaha (Training-cum-Placement Officer, University Institute of Applied Management Sciences, Panjab University, Chandigarh), Prof. Deepti Gupta (Chairperson Department of English and Cultural Studies, Panjab University), Mr. Vikram Dhawan (123 Startup Ventures Founder), Dr. Swati Dhawan (123 Startup Ventures Co-founder), Dr. Preeti Vohra (Behavioral Counselor and Motivational Speaker Wellbeing Counselling), and Amanjot Kaur (Director Innovative Financial Management) gave their valuable insights about promoting entrepreneurship culture and practices, and overcoming bottlenecks in this field. Mr. Sidhant Banura emphasized on the need of polishing soft skills of the students apart from strengthening their domain expertise. Dr. Swati Dhawan highlighted the role of capstone projects, counselling and promoting industry readiness in students. Mr. Vikram Dhawan pointed out that besides the perspective of students, it is imperative to understand the psychology of parents, and point of view of entrepreneurs and start-ups. He also enunciated the lack of industry readiness of the students which should be taken up seriously by the stakeholders. Amanjot Kaur added another dimension to the discussion when she mentioned that students who are idea-generators and willing to execute the same should be given extra credits in academics to motivate them. Dr. Amandeep Singh Marwaha also contributed to the discussion by endorsing the role of mentorship so that students receive proper guidance and timeline within which to work. This will enable them to execute their plan of action. The experts also highlighted the role of awareness generation sessions among students regarding funding agencies, legal framework of their start-ups and other technical aspects involved in initiating innovative projects. Dr. Nisha Bhargava also gave her insights regarding the same and thanked all the experts for taking out their precious time, their meaningful observations, ideas and plans in drafting policies regarding the promotion of innovation and start-ups. The session ended on a promising note of taking the NISP unit of the College ahead and encouraging students to be innovative and develop a spirit of entrepreneurship. The NISP co-ordinator Dr. Kiran Jindal moderated the session well and thanked all experts for their contribution and efforts.

Along with it, start-up policy of the college was designed in line with the NISP issued by MHRD, GOI and uploaded on college website.
