The Canteen Committee members inspected the canteen, fruit shop, Nescafe and Bakery House on various parameters like cleanliness of surroundings, food storage, food preparation, disposal and hygiene of the workers.

All the vendors were asked to discontinue the use of refined flour and instead use breads, burgers, samosa etc. of whole wheat flour. Furthermore, they were instructed to follow the norms regarding one time use plastic containers, cutlery and carry bags. Instead, they were encouraged to use bio-degradable material like paper plates, wooden stirrers etc. Time to time checks are made by the committee members to monitor the proper disposal of food waste from the canteen and other eateries along with hygiene practises regarding storage and service of the various food items. To save non-renewable sources of energy and overhead cost, the bio fuel used for cooking in the canteen is generated by the biogas plant which is run by kitchen waste of the mess. Regular checks were made to assess the status of COVID Vaccination of the workers handling serving and preparation of food items. They were encouraged to get the Booster Dose, so to avoid any community spread.
