

The year posed several challenges in the form of lockdown and lack of mobility. However, the team of the Placement Cell under the guidance of our principal madam Dr. Nisha Bhargava innovated and devised new ways to keep the students abreast with the developments in the respective fields.

We arranged online orientation sessions, organized Placement Drives and also explored new companies to offer internship opportunities to our students. With the continued efforts of the team, we placed 79 students and also got letters of internships for 110 students. The next year will be a year of a renewed focus on preparing students for the modified requirements of the companies.

Dr. Mamta Ratti Coordinator Placement Cell Lockdown, which was imposed owing to Covid-19, posed many challenges in the process of placement and recruitment. However, the Placement Cell of the College utilized these challenges and turned them into opportunities by arranging online Placement Drives, Orientation sessions and Workshop for students aspiring to get placements or simply looking to brush up their skills and enhance employability. The academic year 2020-21 began with Placement Drives of Bank of America, BSCJE, Infosys, Deloitte, TCS, EY GDS, Quik Relations, IDS Infotech Ltd., Aerial Telecom Solutions, Teleperformance, British Counsel, Healthviser Pvt. Ltd., Algomil IT Solutions, Baldev Kumar & Co., Competent Synergies, Saupins School, Raj Malhotra IAS Academy, OSI Systems Pvt Ltd., Devi Graphics, New Directions Counselling Services, Aartoon-Online School of Animation & Digital Art, Felix Advisory and Sindhi Trunk House.

Orientation Sessions:



Various companies were invited to conduct orientation sessions to facilitate the interaction between companies and students with a view to familiarize the students with the respective companies, their profiles and the requirements of the companies with regard to the job roles. These sessions were conducted in March, 2021.

They were conducted in an online mode with student participants, faculty members and officials of the respective companies which included Teleperformance, Smashqeen, Algomill, Sebiz Info Tech Pvt Ltd., Wedding Asia, Healthviser and Nestle India. The students found the sessions very informative and the sessions also helped them to focus on the areas where they needed to

work on. The representatives of the companies were able to gauge the kind of candidates that the College had groomed and came up with different profiles as per the qualification and skill sets of students. Many of them expressed that more companies should visit the College and interact with them to further expose them to various companies.

Internships:

Many companies offered internships to around 110 students. The companies that shortlisted candidates for internships included Girl Power, KRG Strategy, Unnati, Development Channel, Dais Channel, New Directions Counselling Services, Unschool Internship, Youth India Foundation and Aarya-Ray of Hope. Internships add value to the candidature of a student and enable her to gain experience and apply the learnt skills to job situations.

The Placement Cell of the College undertakes different activities and plans various events for the students. We direct our efforts towards fulfilling the professional aspirations of the students as they near completion of graduation and post graduation in College. The time of lockdown did pose challenges in terms of students not willing to go to remote locations. At the same time, the online system was leveraged upon by tapping those students who lived in far off areas by arranging online sessions and meets.

Ltd., Bank of America, TCS Smart Hiring, British Counsel, Wipro, Competent Synergies, Baldev Kumar & Co., Teleperformance, Saupins School, Devi Graphics, Healthviser Pvt. Ltd and Sindhi Trunk House. The maximum salary that was offered to a candidate was Rs. 3.8 lacs per annum by Deloitte in profiles of Associate Analyst- Deloitee Consulting and Associate Analyst- Deloitee Risk and Financial Advisory.

A total of 98 students registered for the placement drive for Ernst & Young Global Delivery Services (EY GDS) organised from April 24th, 2021 to April 26th, 2021 and after a rigorous procedure involving Online test, Telephonic interview and final interview, 12 students were selected for Noida region, NCR.



The Placement Cell plans to continue with the efforts to prepare students for the various job profiles and also conduct Placement Drives of reputed companies as per the aspirations and qualifications of the students. We also intend to take initiatives for conducting more orientation sessions to acquaint the candidates with different companies to enable them to make an informed career choice. With the emphasis on candidates trained in soft skills, we also plan to undertake workshops for the students to help them hone their interpersonal skills and perform better in interviews. Consistent efforts for a higher number of campus placements remains the commitment of the Placement Cell of the College.
