

This AGREEMENT is entered at Chandigarh on 15th Day of the month of September 2021

Between

M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION having its registered office address at Plot No 67-B, Lodhi Majra Industrial Area, Baddi, Tehsil Nalagarh (H.P). Herein referred to as Recycler.

And

Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women, Sector 36- A, Chandigarh having its registered office at Sector 36-A Chandigarh. Herein referred to as Generator.

AND WHEREAS, the foremost and the sole objective of M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION is to prevent Environmental Pollution Hazards and to observe the existing laws on Environmental Pollution Control

AND WHEREAS, the GENERATOR desires to send its /E-Waste (hereinafter referred to as 'HAZARDOUS WASTE') to M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION as per the norms of Himachal Pradesh State Pollution Control Board (hereinafter referred to as "HPSPCB") and M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION having requisite facilities in this behalf, agrees to receive the E-Waste sent by the GENERATOR on the terms and conditions stated hereunder, which have been mutually agreed to by and between M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION and the MEMBER.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT

witnesses as follows.

SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT

M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION shall collect, transport, and dispose the E-Waste collected from the premises of the Generator. It shall be the responsibility of M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION to demagnetize the hard disks before disposing them off in accordance with the terms of the contract. If the hard disks come along with the CPU the activity would be taken care by M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION at free of cost.

Upon intimation from the Generator, OIC shall within 2 days, arrange for collection of E-Waste irrespective of the quantity as per the applicable provisions from MCM DAV College, College Road, Sector 36-A Chandigarh. The Generator shall issue delivery challan/bill before collection of the E-Waste from the designated place by "OIC"

The Generator liability shall cease once the E-Waste has been collected by "OIC" from its premises except for any non-disclosure of any material information known to the Generator with regard to E-Waste from "OIC" during the handover of such E- Waste. It is specifically agreed and understood that compliances of applicable law During transportation and disposal of E-Waste shall be exclusive responsibility of the "OIC"

within forty-five (45) days from receipt of such request.

PAYMENTS

M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION shall not be liable to pay any amount to the generator for collection of E-Waste. Whereas the generator is liable to pay an amount of Rs. 10000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) inclusive of GST to the Recycler for a period of two years. The payment shall be made to M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION in the form of electronic transfer/ cheque.

TERM AND TERMINATION

This Agreement shall be in force for a period of 2 years from the date of signing of this Agreement. Upon completion of the term, the Agreement may be renewed at the option of both the Parties in writing on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

The Agreement may be terminated by either party without assigning any reason, by giving thirty (30) days prior written notice to the other Party.

COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS

M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION represents and warrants to the Generator that it has all necessary statutory permissions, consents, approvals and licenses to carry out business of collection, transportation, storage, management and disposal of E-Waste and it shall maintain all such permissions, consents, approvals and licenses during the term of this Agreement.

M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION further agrees that:

- i. It shall exercise all safety precaution and best management practices, required by law, in providing service under this Agreement;
- ii. It shall notify the Generator immediately if any permit, licenses, certificate, consent approval or identification number required for the performance of its service under this Agreement has been revoked, modified, expired, suspended or not been renewed;
- iii. M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION shall comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations and shall indemnify and hold the Generator harmless in this regard.

ENVIRONMENTAL AND SAFETY AUDITS

1. M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION agrees and acknowledges that the Generator or its authorized agent shall have the right to perform environmental and safety audit at any site at which M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION is conducting E-Waste management services for the purpose of verifying environmental and safety procedures followed by M/s ORTECH INDIA CORPORATION.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

1. This Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of India.
2. Any dispute or breach arising out of or in relation to this Agreement shall be referred to arbitration to be conducted by a sole arbitrator mutually appointed by the parties herein, in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The venue of arbitration shall be Himachal Pradesh and the proceedings shall be conducted in English. The decision of the arbitration shall be final and binding on both the Parties. No Party shall make public the award of the arbitration without the prior written consent of the other Party. The Party in default shall bear the cost of arbitration.
3. Subject to the arbitration provisions herein, courts of competent jurisdiction in Himachal Pradesh shall have the exclusive jurisdiction on the matters arising out of or in connection with this Agreement. No Party shall be restrained from approaching the court for seeking interim relief under this Agreement.

MISCELLANEOUS

1. Force Majeure: Neither party shall be liable for any delay or failure to perform its obligations here under, if such delay or failure is due to reasons beyond the control of the concerned party due to any Force Majeure event which shall include but not limited to, strikes, riots, wars, fires, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, unusually severe weather, earth quakes, explosions, acts of God or state or any public enemy or acts mandated by applicable laws, regulation or order of any Governmental body. The Party affected by such Force Majeure event shall immediately notify the other Party who shall have the right to terminate the Agreement with immediate effect upon giving a written notice if such Force Majeure event continues for more than sixty (60) days.
2. Confidentiality: The existence and all terms and conditions of this Agreement are confidential to the Parties, and shall not be disclosed to any third party without the other party's prior written consent, save and except to their respective officers, employees or as required by law on a need-to-know basis. The confidentiality obligation under this Agreement shall exist during the term of this Agreement and for a period of three (3) years from the expiry of this Agreement.
3. Notice: Any notice or other communication under or in connection with this agreement shall be in writing in the English language and shall be delivered personally or delivered to the party due to receive the notice or communication at its address set out below or such other address as either party may specify by notice in writing to other from time to time.
4. Amendment & Modification: Amendments and modifications to this Agreement shall be valid only if made in writing and signed by the Parties.


5. No Representation: Nothing in this Agreement shall authorize any Party to engage in transactions in the name of the other Party or in any activities, which may create a liability on such other Party.
6. No Assignment: Parties shall not assign or transfer this Agreement or any Order or any parts of its rights and obligations hereunder to any person or corporation without the prior written consent of the other Party.
7. No Waiver: No failure to exercise, nor any delay in exercising, on the part of either Party, any right or remedy hereunder shall operate as a waiver thereof, nor shall any single or partial exercise of any right or remedy prevent any further or other exercise thereof or the exercise of any other right or remedy.
8. Headings: The headings of the Clauses of this Agreement are for convenience only and shall have no effect in the interpretation of this Agreement.
9. Entire Agreement: This Agreement and the Order(s) constitute the entire agreement between the Parties.
10. Duplicate Agreements: This Agreement has been signed in two counterparts, each of which shall be deemed as an original but both of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument.



Title of the Activity: 'E-Safe' to mark the celebration of International E-Waste Day

Date: 11-10-2021

Department/Committee: Department of Environment under the aegis of sustainable practices committee

No. of participants: 46

Objectives:

- To aware students about the hazards of e-waste
- To encourage them for the proper recycling and disposal of any form of e-waste by handing over it to the authorized recyclers instead of giving it to unauthorized scrap dealers.

Context: 14 October, was developed as International E-Waste Day by the **Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE)** Forum in 2018 in order to raise awareness among the public about the hazards of e-waste and to encourage consumers to recycle their WEEE. According to the UN, in the year 2021, each person on the planet will produce an average of 7.6 kg of e-waste, which means a total of 57.4 million tonnes of e-waste will be generated worldwide. Only 17.4 % of this hazardous waste, will be properly collected, treated, and recycled. Since the last two years, owing to the Covid-19 outbreak, the usage of e-products has been drastically increased as people rely on e-products to stay connected with their family, friends, and colleagues, resulting in tonnes of e-waste generation. This year, International E-Waste Day focuses on the role of consumers in making circularity a reality for e-products. Unfortunately, consumers are unaware of the hazardous impacts of e-waste. So, before expecting that a consumer should go for recycling and proper disposal of e-waste, it is requisite to acquaint them with proper knowledge that what is e-waste, which household products are included in e-waste, and what are their health impacts.

Practice: On the above grounds, the Sustainable practices committee of the college, organized 'E-Safe' on 11, October 2021, an event to mark the celebration of **International E-waste Day**. The college has signed a two-year agreement with **Ortech India Corporation**, Baddi, Himachal Pradesh, an authorized recycler under **Chandigarh Pollution Control Board**. Students and faculty members were encouraged to get e-waste from their homes and put it in the red bin already installed in the college for e-waste collection. The committee has handed over **67 Kg** of collected e-waste to the recycler for its proper disposal. Under the same event, the Director of **Ortech India Corporation, Mr. Rohit Puri** delivered an awareness lecture about the hazardous impacts of e-waste on the environment and how we are exposed to the toxic chemicals present in e-waste through the environment. For more awareness, students were shown an encouraging animated video on e-waste. A total of 46 students and 6 faculty members were attended the same.

Evidence of Success: Enthusiastic Participation of over 46students shows the great success of this event.
