The meet ushered in a new dawn of hope with its theme of “Sustainability: Weaving threads of Identity, Creativity and Joy’ aiming to understand issues pertaining to climate change, organic food, green packaging, water conservation in conjunction with matters/questions about whether everybody has equal access to the basic amenities, time for recreation and leisure, inclination towards creativity and much more.
