

Report of Exit Survey (2021-22)

An educational institution plays a crucial role in imparting knowledge, skills, and cultural values to students through a systematic approach. As students are the primary stakeholders of an educational institution, it is essential to evaluate their aspirations and needs to enhance the quality of the teaching-learning process. To gather student feedback, our institution employs a structured questionnaire covering diverse aspects such as curriculum, infrastructure, governance, and student support services. Outgoing students are requested to fill the questionnaire online, providing their response on a five-point scale ranging from 1 for Strongly Disagree to 5 for Strongly Agree. For the session 2021-22, we received feedback from 480 students, and the findings are presented below.



1. Opinion about Academic experience




Academically Enriching and Rewarding

2. Environment of the college


• More than 93% of the students termed environment as stimulating and challenging

Around 86% of the students said that the College offered adequate choice of Elective Subjects.


5. Reason for Choosing the institution

Which of the following qualities have been inculcated in you during the learning experience in the College?




 Confidence, skills, value and Team Spirit were termed as most likely qualities to be inculcated in a student.
