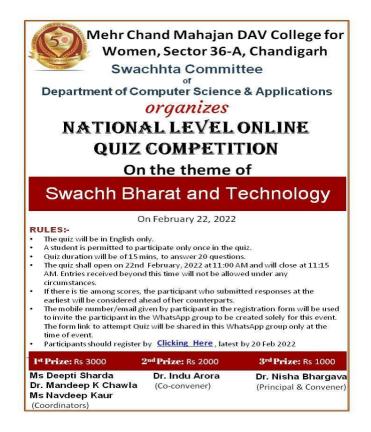

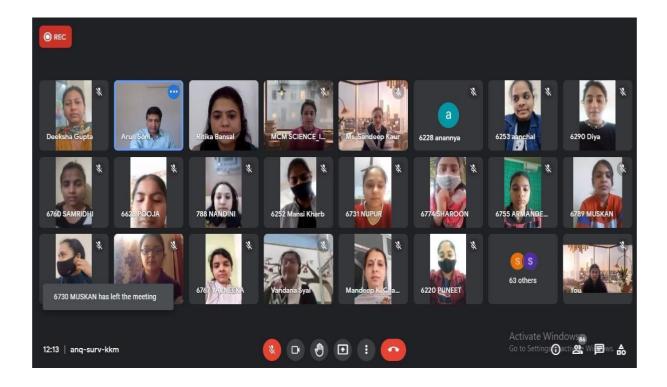

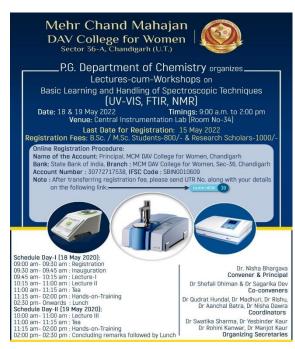

COMBATING CYBER CRIME DURING COVID19

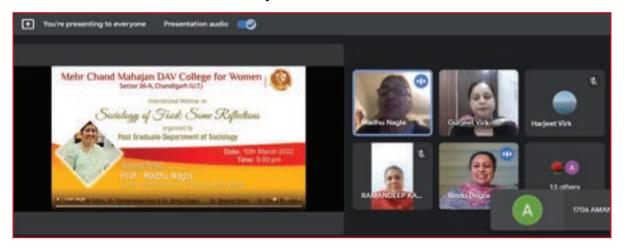

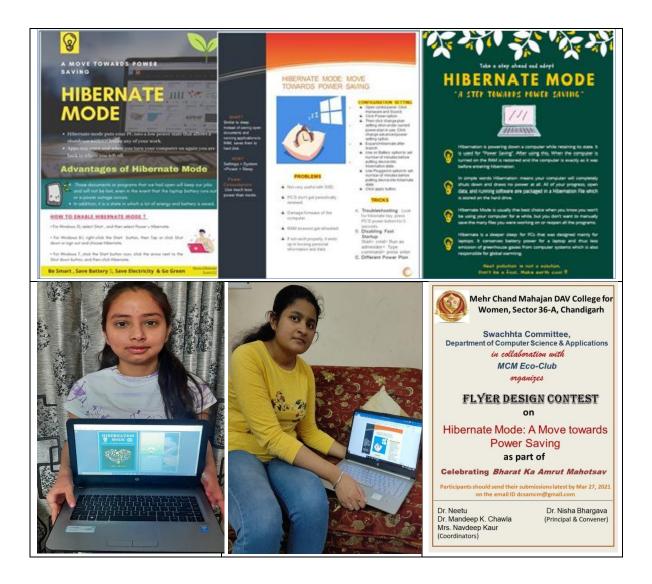

BUSINESS MODEL CANVAS

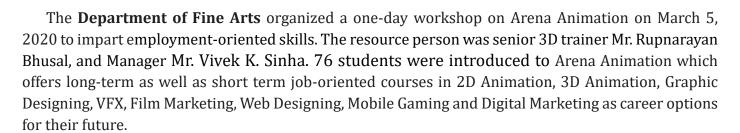

WORKSHOP ON MIS

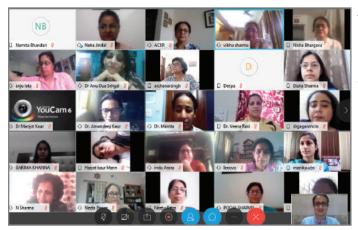

SUSTAINABLE URBAN FARMING

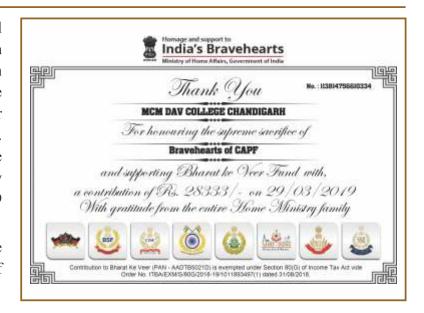

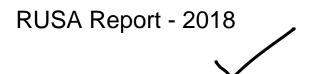

SUSTAINABLE URBAN FARMING

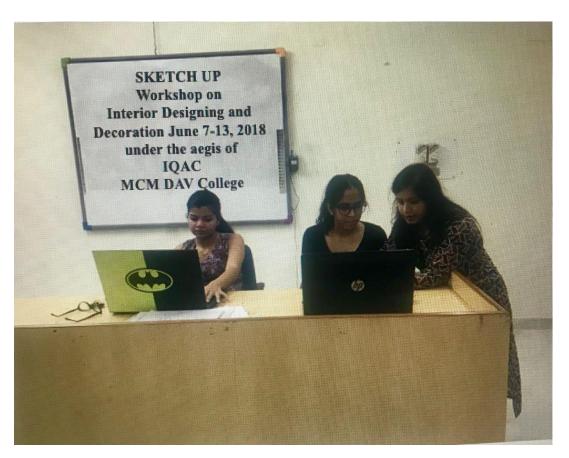
