COMMON USES	<ol> <li>These are responsible for coastal sand dune stabilization erosion control.</li> <li>It is widely used in agro forestry in saline and coastal regions.</li> <li>Wood is used as a fuel. It helps make a high quality charcoal.</li> <li>The wood produces paper pulp using semi-chemical processes.</li> <li>Root of this plant is used to treat dysentery, diarrhea and stomach ache.</li> </ol>
