

FUN FACT The meaning of the word "Rudraksha" is the 'Eyes of Rudra' (Shiva) and his tears (Aksha). It is spiritually meant to purify and protect the soul.

COMMON USES

- 1. In Ayurveda, every part of this plant has been used to cure many ailments, its leaves are an antidote to poisoning and its fruits are used to treat dysentery and diarrhoea.
- 2. For Nepalis, this plant has a great medicinal and religious value. The juice of its bark is used for treatment of jaundice, while its seed paste is eaten for the treatment for pneumonia and ulcers.
- 3. The Karbi people of Assam, harvest both ripe and unripe fruit to make pickles and chutneys from them.
- 4. Its fruits have abundant amounts of starch and sugar Due to its constipating properties, it helps in treating diarrhoea.
