In pursuance of its significant judgment dated 8 May 2009 in Civil Appeal No. 887/2009 which was notified by UGC as 'Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009' and subsequent communications received from the Ministry of Human Resource and Development from time to time, relevant steps were to curb, prevent and eliminate the menace of ragging.

Significant steps taken during the session in this direction include:

Introduction of the freshers with the Committee:

During the Induction/Orientation Programme held in the online mode during the Covid-19 Pandemic, the Convener and members of the Anti-ragging Cell were introduced to the new students. The senior students introduced them to the mandatory rules and regulations meant to prevent ragging. This was done through creative posters, innovative songs and meaningful skits presented online.

In her address to the student, the Principal of the college also sensitized the students about the evil of ragging.

Events to Promote Awareness:

- 1. A letter in the form of an e-mail was sent to the parents of all the students of BA II and BA III before the beginning of the session to sensitize them both regarding the evil of ragging.
- 2. Anti-Ragging Posters prescribed by the UGC as well as those made by the students were displayed at prominent places in the Campus and hostel to sensitize the students against the evil of Ragging.



3. Poster Making Contest:

The Anti-Ragging Cell under the aegis of IQAC organized a Poster Making Contest on the theme of 'Say No to Ragging'was held on 28 September, 2022 to spread awareness about the evils of Ragging. The participants were given a week to prepare their posters and and submit the same to

the committee. The contest was open to all the students of all classes and streams.



A total of 58 entries were received which were judged by a panel of judges including Dr. VandanaSyal, Associate Professor, Department of Computer Science and Applications; Dr. Pooja Sharma, Head, Department of Fine Arts, and Ms. Robina, Assistant Professor, Department of Fine Arts. Cash Prizes worth Rs. 2000/-, Rs. 1500 and Rs. 1000 were awarded to the winners.





Ms. Samiksha of BA III bagged the First prize while Ms. Anubha Sharma and Ms. Ravneet of BA III got the Second and Third prize respectively. Ms. Kashvi (B Com-I), Manpreet (BA III) and Ms. Anushka (B Com-I) were given Consolation prizes.

Prize Winning Posters were later framed and displayed prominently in the Students' Common Room.

5. Sensitization Programme:

The Anti-Ragging Cell organized a Sensitization Programme on 18 March 2023 to sensitize the students about the need to preserve and value everyone's dignity.Participants included the members of the Anti-ragging Squad, incharges of various hostel committees and Student Council. They were apprised of the need to maintain discipline, harmony and inclusiveness both within the hostel and the Campus. They were also told about the forthcoming NAAC Peer Team Visit.

Convener of the Student Council, D. Mini Grewal; Mrs. Madhvi Bajaj, Convener, Hostel Grievance Redressal Cell, and Dr. Bindu Sharma, Convener, Anti-Ragging Cell addressed the students.
