### September 2022

# January 2023

Electoral Literacy Clubconducted an 'Online Essay Writing Competition' on the theme of 'Nothing like Voting, I Vote for Sure' A total number of 28 students participated in the competition. Diksha from BA III was given the first prize, whereas, Jessica Saini and Pearl from BAIII were given the second and third prizes, respectively. Ashmeet from Bsc II and Amisha Goel from BAIII were given consolation prizes. The winners were awarded with the cash prizes of Rs 1500, Rs 1000, Rs 500 for first, second and third, respectively and Rs 250 each for consolation. Participation certificates were given to all the participants.

The club of the college marked the celebration of 'National Voter's Day' on January 25, 2023. A Voter card registration booth was established where a number of queries were taken and 15 students were registered as voters.
