Report of Home Science Workshops & Activities (2022-23)

With the aim of inculcating artistry and encouraging sustainability practices among the students, the Department of Home Science, Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women, Sector 36, Chandigarh organised a 3-day Workshop 'Kala Utsav in collaboration with Fevicryl (Pidilite Industries) from 21st - 23rd September 2022.
