Activity 2 : One-day online workshop on "Gender Responsive Approach to Climate Change"



The Foreign Students' Cell and Women Development Cell of Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for women organized a one-day online workshop on "Gender Responsive Approach to Climate Change" on 10th November 2022. The eminent resource person, Prof. Namita Gupta from the Department of Human Rights, Panjab University, Chandigarh, lent an exhaustive narrative to the contemporary cum sensitive issue of women being the lead victims of the holocaust of climate changes and natural disasters. She said that the burgeoning statistics have been a precursor to the desired emergence of various environmental movements of India like Bishnoi movement, Chipko Movement, Aapiko movement, Silent valley movement and Narmada Bachao Andolan, to name a few. Prof. Namita Gupta corroborated her talk with research-based constructs in the domains of agriculture, plantation, mining, household chores, migration, and politics etc., all bearing testimony to the genderbased hiatus skewed towards women in society. She alluded to the famous environment sustainability books like 'Silent Spring' and highlighted the categoric significance of equal opportunities to cast a strong influence in the sphere of Land and Property Governance, and the overall polity of the country and the world at large. Prof. Namita Gupta, being a hard-core positivist, reinforced the role of women in the mainstream of livelihood crusades backed by their vehement decision-making powers. The session exuded an overwhelming response from over eighty students who participated in the event with rapt attention. The students raised queries which were promptly addressed by Prof. Namita Gupta in both letter and content, with examples from countries like Switzerland. Around 85 participants were part of this online workshop.



Activity 3: Pad Collection Drive: "Donate a Pad"

Activity 4: Pad Distribution Drive:

The economic crisis that has arisen due to COVID-19 has created challenges for girls in the slums. Lack of access to sanitary pads has led to health and hygiene problems like UTI's and endometritis that not only cause daily discomfort but can also lead to cervical cancer, fibroids, and cysts that are often left unattended. The psychological impact of not being able to function during their period cycle not only damages the mental health of girls but impedes on their education.

Women Development Cell, Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women, Chandigarh took an initiative to conducted a drive on "Sanitary Pads Distribution" for the underprivileged women of Attawa village, Sec-42, Chandigarh and slum area of sector 25, Chandigarh to mark International Women's Day Celebrations on 8th March,2023. This activity was in continuation with the drive conducted on "Pad Collection for Donation" held on 20th and 21st February, 2023.

Poor women struggle to get a clean piece of cloth to manage their period every month. There is a lack of awareness about menstrual health and hygiene. Living in a culture of shame and silence, they end up using poor substitutes like rags and ash, or worse they use NOTHING.

Students also performed a play and interacted with the underprivileged women on the theme: "Menstrual Hygiene and its importance". The students participated enthusiastically to make this drive a success.


- To provide the students with the opportunity to develop their skills in cutting, styling and coloring hair of different types and lengths.
