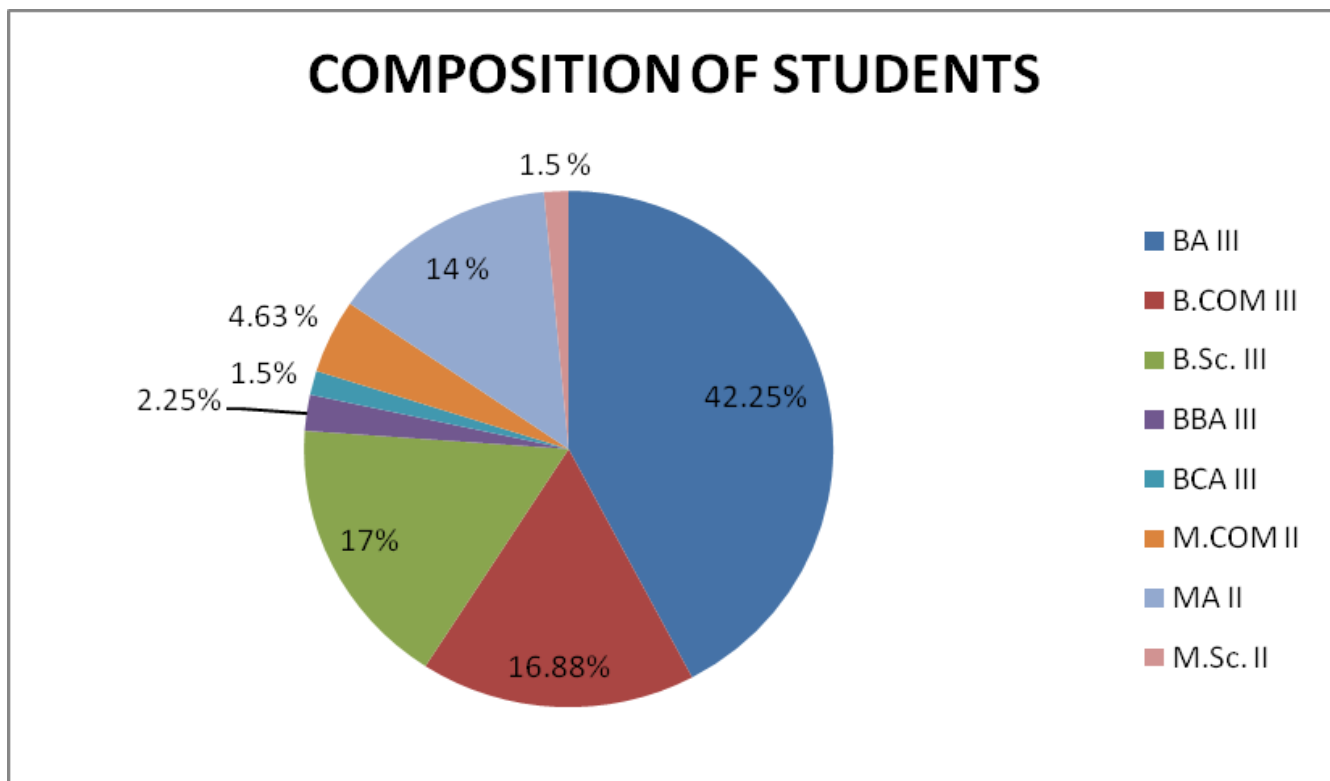


Report of Exit Survey (2022-23)

An educational institution plays a crucial role in imparting knowledge, skills, and cultural values to students through a systematic approach. As students are the primary stakeholders of an educational institution, it is essential to evaluate their aspirations and needs to enhance the quality of the teaching-learning process. To gather student feedback, our institution employs a structured questionnaire covering diverse aspects such as curriculum, infrastructure, governance, and student support services. Outgoing students are requested to fill the questionnaire online, providing their response on a five-point scale ranging from 1 for Strongly Disagree to 5 for Strongly Agree. For the session 2022-23, we received feedback from 800 students, and the findings are presented below.

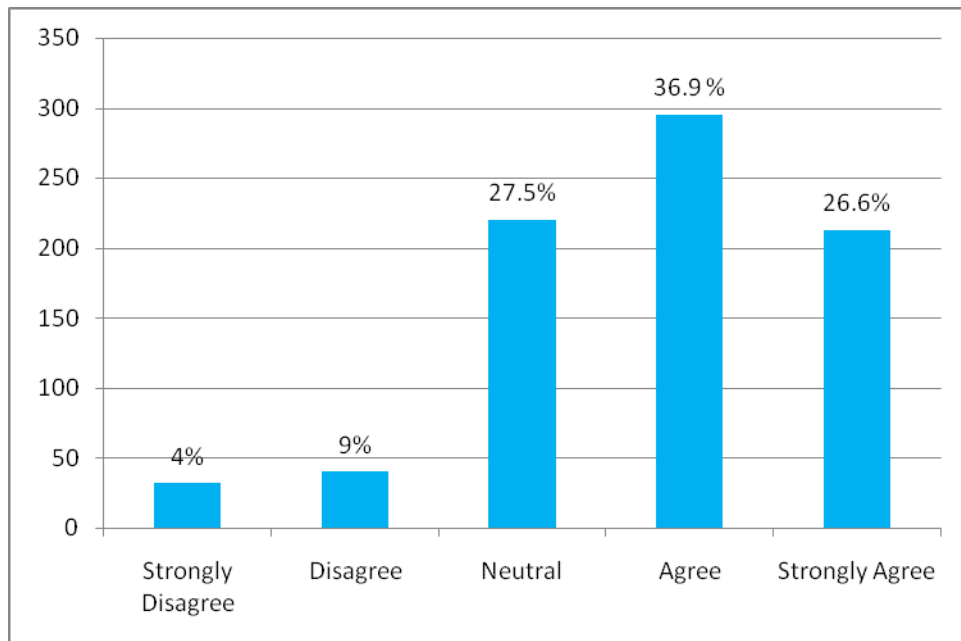

Figure 2 shows that 26.6% of students strongly agree and 36.9% of students agree that their overall academic experience in the college was enriching and rewarding.

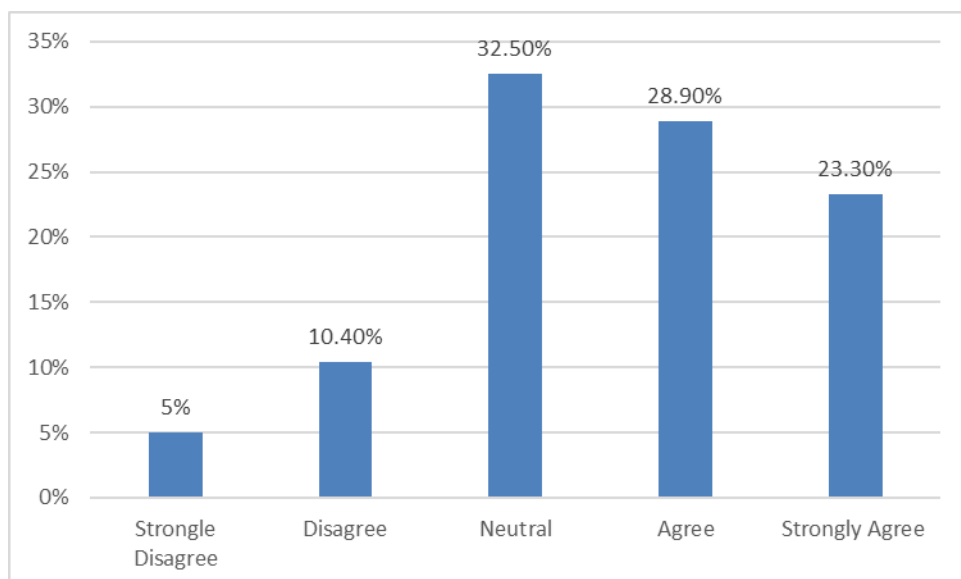

Figure 3 shows that 23.3% of students strongly agree and 28.9 % agree that college environment is stimulating and challenging.

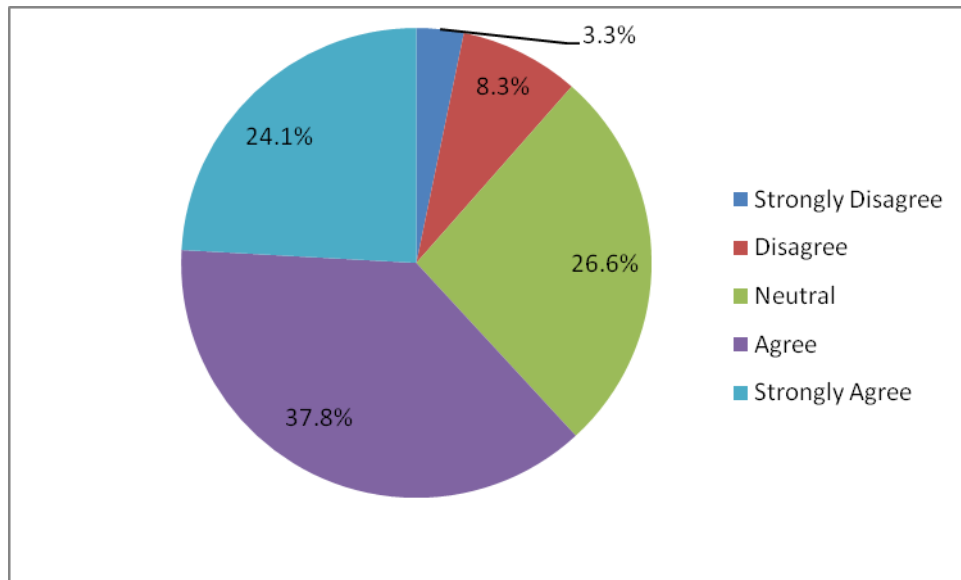

Figure 4 shows that approximately 37.8% of students agree and 24.1% of students strongly agree that course specific outcomes were achieved by the college

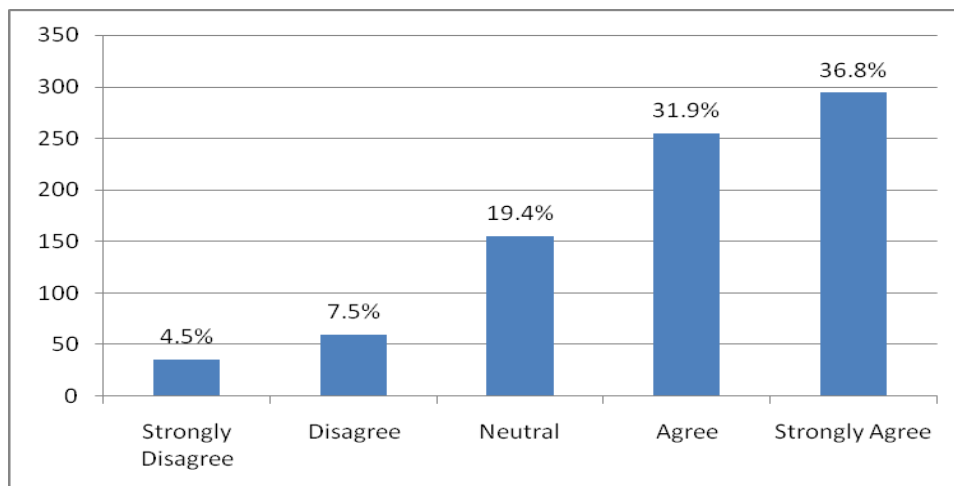

Figure 5 shows that 36.8% students strongly agree and 31.9% students agree that the college offered adequate choice of Elective subjects.

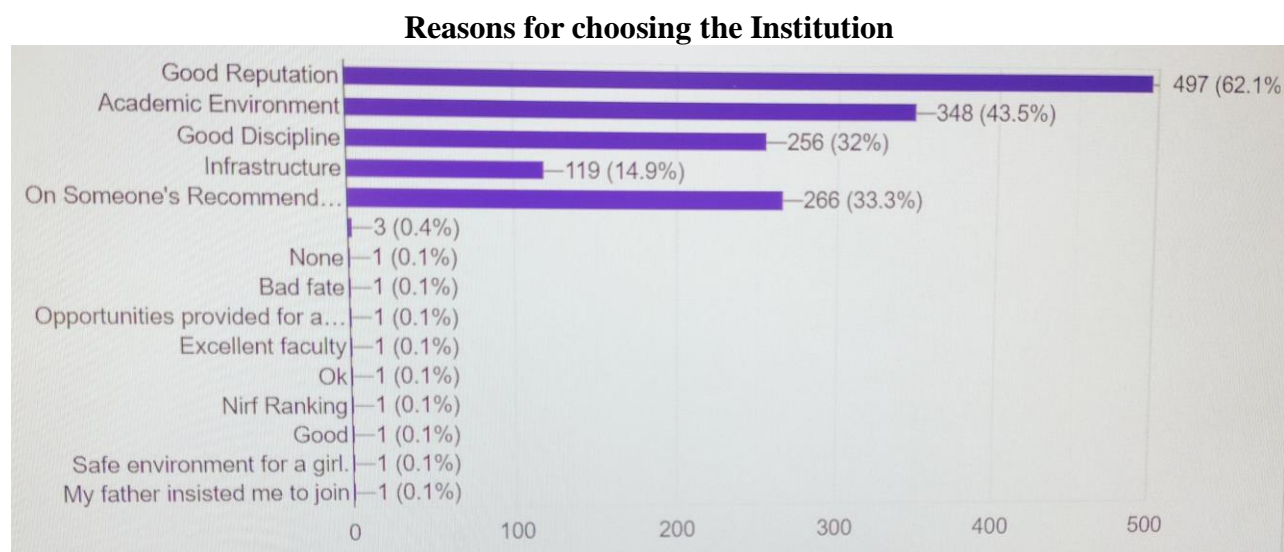

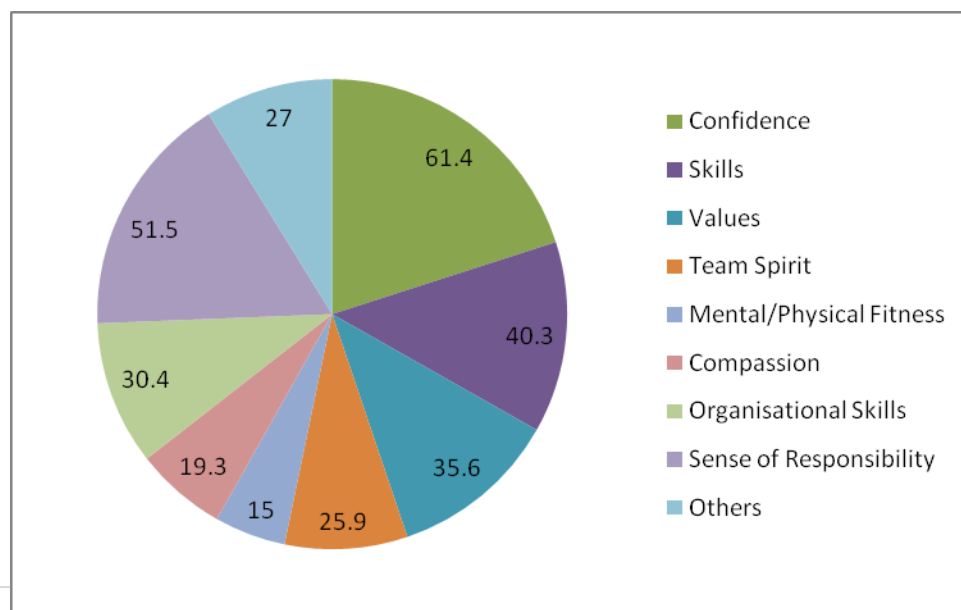


Qualities Inculcated by the College

Overall Experience

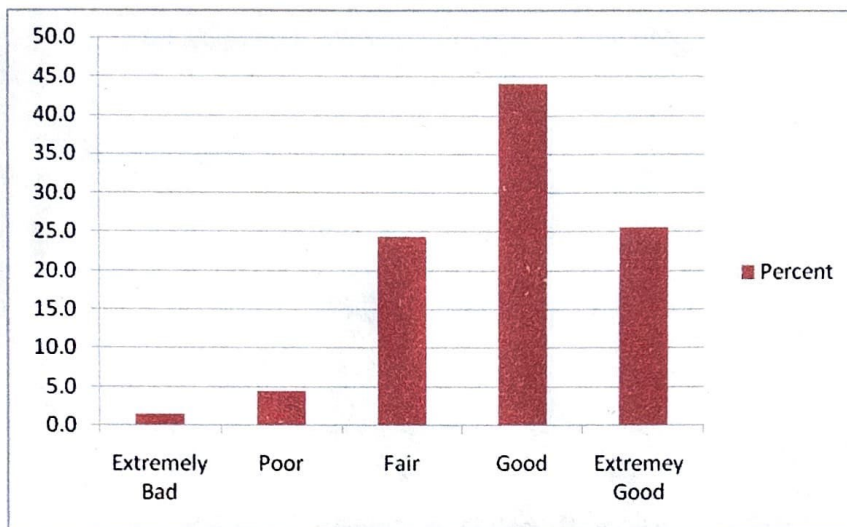
