



On 11th December 2023 the Honourable Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi launched 'Viksit Bharat @2047: Voice of Youth' via video conferencing where he addressed the youth, the Vice Chancellors of Universities, Heads of Institutes and faculty members across the country to mark the beginning of this initiative.


