The institutional initiatives for greening the campus are as follows:

1. Restricted Entry of automobiles: The institution adheres to rule of restricted entry of automobiles within the campus.



Restricted Parking as facility is there only for Staff members

2. Use of Bicycles/ Battery powered vehicles: The campus has battery-operated vehicle in order to ferry the stationary from one place to another. It is also used for the hostel students for carrying their luggage up to the college main gate. These eco-friendly measures are cost effective and convenient to use. It cost less to run and are more affordable. In addition, 6 bicycles (4 purchased in 2020 and 2 in 2015) have been purchased for convenient pollution free movement of the stakeholders within the city.








BICYCLES AND BATTERY OPERATED VECHICLE

3. Pedestrian Friendly pathways

The institution has separate parking facilities for two wheelers and four wheelers for students and staffs separately. No one is permitted to take their vehicles beyond the parking lot and are restricted to have their vehicles in specified areas. The usage of pedestrian friendly pathway ensures the safety of the commuters (both students and staffs) within the campus.









4. Ban on use of Plastic: *The Saying "no"* to single-use *plastic* is one way for students to get the ways to say no using *plastic* and how it can potentially harm the environment. Plastic has become hazardous to all forms of life. The campus promotes "No to Plastic" as part of policy.





5. Landscaping with trees and plants: Trees are a great way to improve the overall aesthetics of the campus. It provides Shade and beautification of the campus. The campus has created Outdoor Learning Space and helps in improving air quality.
