## 2. Interactive Session on "Health and Anti-Aging for Young Girls"


The Red Ribbon Club/AIDS Awareness Committee in collaboration with the Post Graduate Department of Sociology of Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women, Chandigarh organized an Interactive Session on "Health and Anti-Aging for Young Girls" by Gynaecology Expert and Director of The Touch Clinic Dr Preeti Jindal, on 12th September, 2023.

After a formal introduction of the speaker and the relevance of such sessions, the event started off with discussion about common cancers among women which included ovarian, breast and cervical cancers with the cervical cancer being the most common in India as almost 200 women die from the cancer nationwide with about 1 women dying every 7 minutes. She highlighted that the prevention of the cancer through PAP Smear can be done anytime. She apprised the audience on HPV vaccination which includes only two doses for girls between the age group of 8 to 14 years to prevent the HPV infection which is sexually transmitted. She regarded it as life-saving for all young girls. Then, the young audience got a brief about the Breast cancer, the genes responsible for it (BRCA 1 and 2), its causes as well as its prevention which is through commonly known technique of Mammography (now replaced by breast ultrasound ) and Self Examination. She also took up the prevalent topic of PCOD (Polycystic Ovarian Disease) which leads to irregular periods due to delayed ovulation. Its symptoms include hairfall, weight gain, acne and also how it is a mere lifestyle disorder. She also expressed her concern regarding many women, particularly in Punjab, having their uteruses' removed when they get fibroids. She gave a vital information that there is no such need to do so as fibroids are very common and do not lead to excessive bleeding. She also enlightened the young girls about labiaplasty, hymenoplasty and Egg Freezing which are very rarely discussed. Egg freezing is a technique through which the female eggs in their best stage (i.e, 28 to 33) are saved or 'freezed' to be used at a later stage if any woman wants to attain pregnancy at a later stage. The quality of eggs remains intact (as they are 'frozen'). She talked of recurrent UTI and their preventions by not using products like Vwash. All of this was presented by the speaker through engaging and informative slides with pictorial representation and a demonstration by the gynecologist herself.

The event finally ended with a question -answer round in which students asked personal queries. The students seemed quite interested in the session and were eager to interact more with the speaker. The session thus gave an eye-opening, vivid and enriched knowledge about female health issues. The session was attended by 6 faculty members and 47 students.







#### 3. Blood Donation Camp

The Red Ribbon Club/AIDS Awareness Committee in collaboration with the Medical Committee and NSS team of Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women, Chandigarh organized Blood Donation Camp on 26th September, 2023 in the college campus

#### No. Of participants - 300

#### **Objectives**-

- 1. To raise awareness about the importance of regular blood donation and its positive impact on the community.
- 2. To dispel myths and misconceptions about blood donation and encourages more people to become regular donors.
- 3. To promote healthy eating habits among students to maintain a balanced hemoglobin.

#### Practice-

The college conducted its 20th annual Blood Donation Camp in collaboration with the Department of Transfusion Medicine, Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER). It was led by Dr. Sangeeta, Assistant Professor, Department of Transfusion Medicine. This enduring partnership, which has saved countless lives over the last twenty years, underscores the commitment of both institutions to the cause of blood donation and healthcare. Distinguished guests including Dr. Nemi chand, State Liaison Officer, State NSS Cell, who inaugurated the camp and offered his blessings, alongside Mr. Sunil Kumar, Assistant Director of the Chandigarh State AIDS Control Society, who was the Guest of Honor, graced the occasion. Notably, around 300 students enthusiastically registered for the Camp and contributed to the donation of 70 units of blood. In a heartening display of community support, the event was supported by Sukh Foundation, a charitable organization. Further, the proud blood donors were motivated by the organizing team of the Sukh Foundation to take the organ donation pledge under the aegis of Sewa Pakhwada, the flagship Programme of Ayushman Bhava, Ministry of Health

and Family Welfare. The pledge ignited the spirit of organ donation among the volunteers. All blood donors were presented with discount vouchers offered by local businesses as a token of appreciation. Principal of the college, Dr. Nisha Bhargava commended the tireless efforts of the National Service Scheme (NSS) and the Medical Committee of the college for their exceptional work in organizing the event and contributing to the noble cause. This long-standing collaboration between Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women and PGIMER is a testament to the enduring spirit of community service and the collective commitment to saving lives through blood donation.

#### **Evidence of success-**

The camp saw an impressive turnout, with over 300 students stepping up to donate blood. In total, 70 units were contributed, and these generous donors also took the pledge for organ donation, demonstrating their commitment to saving lives. #### 4. AIDS Awareness Rally 2023

The Red Ribbon Club/AIDS Awareness Committee in collaboration with the NSS team of Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women, Chandigarh organized AIDS awareness rally in the campus on 20<sup>th</sup> November 2023. The theme for this year is "Let Communities Lead"

#### **Objectives** -

- To create awareness among the students about the symptoms, causes and prevention of AIDS
- To sensitize students in college for not taking it as stigma and speak openly about AIDS.
- To encourage students to get tested for HIV/AIDS

**CONTEXT-** Every year December 1 is celebrated as World AIDS day. World AIDS day is a global movement to unite people in the fight against HIV and aids. The NSS units of Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women in collaboration with Red Ribbon Club and AIDS Awareness Committee organized an AIDS awareness rally on 20<sup>th</sup> November 2023 to commemorate World AIDS Day. The rally aimed to raise awareness about the causes, symptoms, and prevention of HIV/AIDS and encourage people to get tested for the virus.

<u>Practice-</u> The rally began at the Celebration ground of the college and proceeded through different departments and venues on the college campus. The volunteers dressed in white t-shirts carried placards with messages about HIV/AIDS prevention and marched enthusiastically while raising slogans such as "Savdhani ko banaye rakho AIDS se khud ko bach aye rakho, Hate the disease but not the diseased" and sensitizing the students about HIV/AIDS. The rally ended at the Principal's office. The Principal of the college Dr. Nisha Bhargava appreciated the efforts of volunteers and said that it is very crucial to create awareness about the disease. She added that it is equally crucial to bust the myths associated with the spread of HIV/AIDS as half-baked information sometimes acts as a deterrent for people to come forward and get themselves tested for the disease.

**Evidence of Success**- The AIDS awareness rally was a resounding success. The rally raised awareness about HIV/AIDS and promoted prevention methods. It witnessed the participation of 31 students and 4 faculty members.











#### 5. An awareness session on My Health My Priority

The Red Ribbon Club/AIDS Awareness Committee in collaboration with the Medical Committee and NSS team of Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women, Chandigarh organized an Interactive Session on "My Health My Priority" by Gynaecologist Dr Namita Grover of Shalby multi-specialist hospital, Mohali on 16th March, 2024.

#### **Objectives:**

To grow and develop in good health, adolescents need information, including age-appropriate comprehensive sexuality education; health services, safe and supportive environments. Expanding such opportunities is key to responding to adolescents' specific needs and rights.

#### **Relevance:**

It is a unique stage of human development and an important phase for laying a foundation for good health. Adolescents experience rapid physical, cognitive and psychosocial growth. During this phase, adolescents establish patterns of behaviour related to diet, physical activity, substance use, and sexual activity which can protect their health and the health of others around them, or put their health at risk now and in the future.

**Practice:** The Red Ribbon Club and the Medical committee of the college regularly organize interactive sessions for students so that it gives them space to talk freely on topics which otherwise they are hesitant to open up with, in front of parents or friends.

**Evidence of Success:** It witnessed the participation of more than 54 students and 7 faculty members.
