1. TITLE: Upgrade 4.0, a weeklong workshop (UGC NET Paper I) by the Samavesh Committee in collaboration with the Career Counselling Cell

Dates: 24th October to 30th October, 2023

Number of participants: 55 participants, 6 resource persons, 3 teachers

Context: Upgrade 4.0 was organized to supplement the preparation of students for various competitive exams with a special focus on UGC NET Paper I.

Objectives: Various sessions conducted in the online workshop aimed to

- Keep the students constructively engaged in the online sessions
- Help them supplement their preparation for competitive exams with a special focus on UGC NET Paper I
- Help them engage with experts in the field for better exposure

Practice: Samavesh Committee, in collaboration with the Career Counselling Cell of the college organized Upgrade 4.0 to help students prepare for UGC NET Paper-I. The seven-day workshop covered topics including Communication Skills, Reading Comprehension, Research Methodology, Teaching Aptitude, and Information & Communication Technology, Reasoning and Maths. A nominal fee of Rs. 200/- per person was charged. Around 55 students registered for the online workshop. Resource persons were invited from Career Launcher, a coaching institute in Chandigarh. The three resource persons were Ms. Sapna, Mr. Vineet, and Mr. Vishal apart from the faculty from the college Dr. R. Ridhi, and Ms. Ruchika who shared their valuable expertise in the respective fields. Dr. Aparna Sharma shared a road map of all the sessions with the students and moderated the sessions. Dr. Minakshi Rana, Co-convener of Samavesh Committee, and Ms. Raman Ghuman, Co-convener of Career Counselling coordinated the sessions and supervised the team during the workshop. At the end of the week long workshop. An online test was conducted and three winners who scored the maximum were given away certificates. Principal of the college, Dr. Nisha Bhargava appreciated the efforts of the Samavesh Committee and Career Counselling Cell for the initiative and added that the workshop will supplement the efforts of the students as they prepare for various competitive exams.

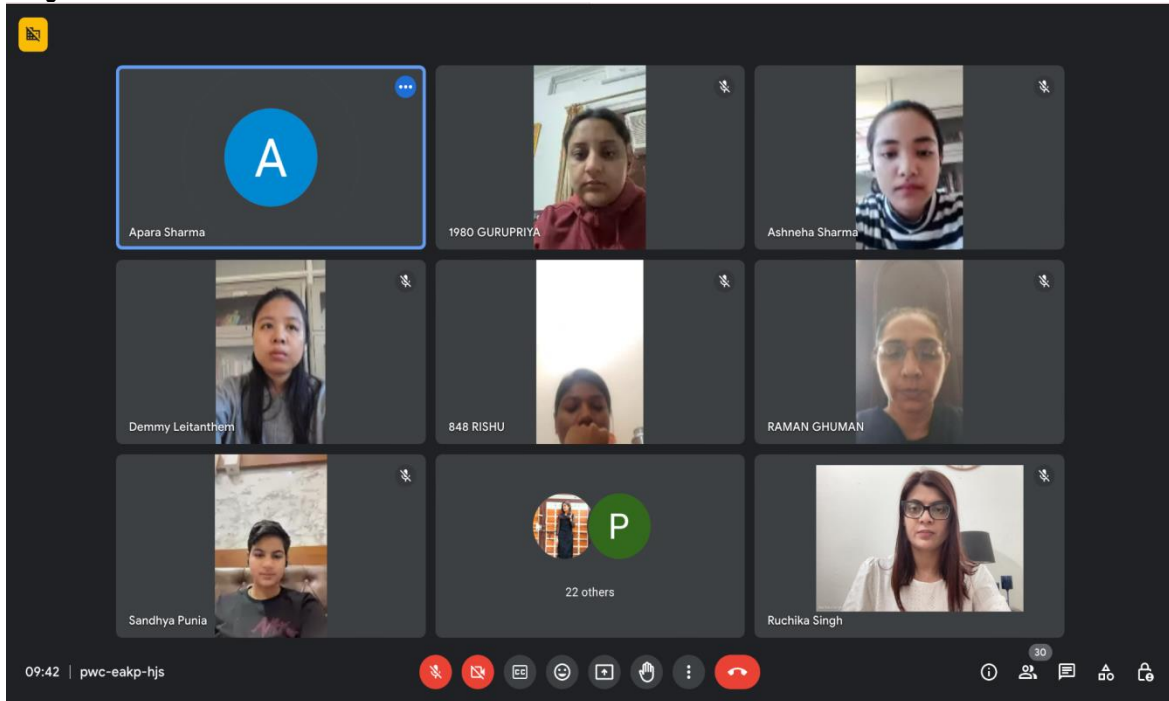

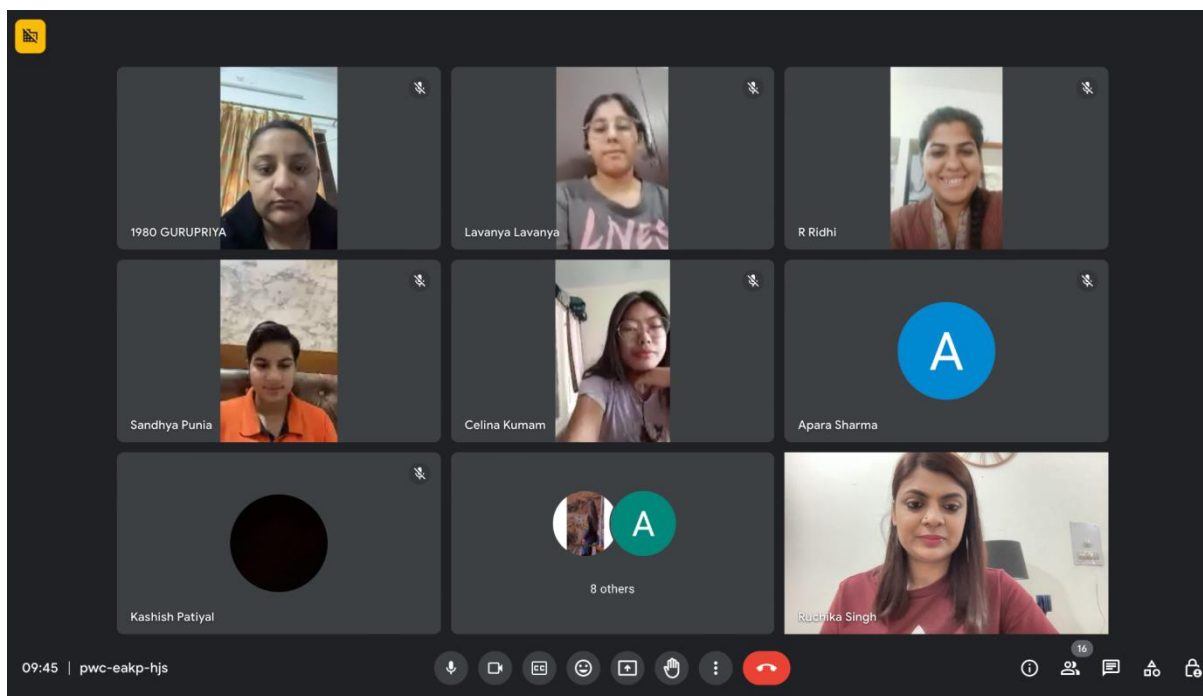

Context:Inan initiative of the Samavesh Committee in collaboration with Character Building Committee, five-day workshop to explain the know-how of reasoning and competitive aptitude was organized. The participants got opportunity to go through the various online and offline sessions on Maths made easy, Vocabulary and reading comprehension, Puzzles, and aptitude test during the workshop.

Objectives:

1. To broadly cover the Logical Reasoning topics of UGC NET/ CAT/ MAT and related competitive examinations.
2. To equip the participants with important trips and tricks to enhance the reasoning efficiency and aptitude.
3. To help the students to gain maximum out of experts' sessions.


Practice:


To inculcate the habit of critical thinking and facilitate the participants in their preparation for various competitive examinations, Mehr Chand Mahajan DAV College for Women organized a 5-day workshop. The workshop covered the topics namely, puzzles, reading comprehension, tips and tricks of maths problems broadly followed by the aptitude test on the last day of the workshop. Mr. Rajiv Sharma, Mr. KJS Sharma, Mr. Rajiv Markanday & Mr. Harinder, from HitBullsEyepvt. Ltd., delivered expert sessions on the above-mentioned topics. A total of 57 students registered and participated in the activity. The first speaker shared the importance of logical reasoning in competitive exams such on the orientation day. Mr. KJS Sharma explained the tips to solve the small maths problems whereas Mr. Rajiv Markanday shared the crucial points to read comprehensions efficiently. Mr. Harinder Singh provided a glance about the interesting puzzle solving skills on 4th day. Different sessions were scheduled in blended mode (both offline and online) keeping in view the convenience of the participants. An aptitude test was conducted on the final day of the workshop and top five

students were selected based on overall assessment and test marks in the aptitude test. The Principal Dr. Nisha Bhargava applauded the efforts of Samvesh committee and Character-Building Committee and added that such efforts add value to the classroom curriculum. Furthermore, the organizing of such events enhances the analytical and problem-solving attitude of the students and assist them to find newer avenues of their interest.

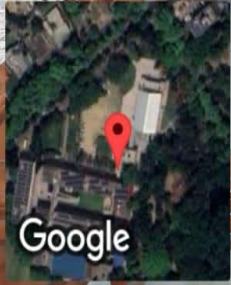
