






Display boards displaying names of Anti-ragging members and hostel grievances redressal Cell placed at various places


 To check the menace of ragging, College authorities have put up notice boards and sun boards at several places warning students not to indulge in ragging as it is a punishable offence.














Anti-ragging Awareness posters and Sun boards with disciplinary instructions for the students have been put up in the corridors.

#### Installation of CCTV Cameras:

CCTV Cameras were installed at vital spots in the campus and hostel to keep a check on the activities of the students in the college premises. 


