



Report of Exit Survey (2023-24)

An educational institution plays a crucial role in imparting knowledge, skills, and cultural values to students through a systematic approach. As students are the primary stakeholders of an educational institution, it is essential to evaluate their aspirations and needs to enhance the quality of the teaching-learning process. To gather student feedback, our institution employs a structured questionnaire covering diverse aspects such as curriculum, infrastructure, governance, and student support services. Outgoing students are requested to fill the questionnaire online, providing their response on a five-point scale ranging from 1 for Strongly Disagree to 5 for Strongly Agree. For the session 2023-24, we received feedback from 522 students, and the findings are presented below.

Students Opinion about the Academic Experience

Figure 2 shows that 23.40 % of students strongly agree and 38.30% of students agree that their overall academic experience in the college was enriching and rewarding.

Figure 3 shows that 16.10% of students strongly agree and 30.10% agree that college environment is stimulating and challenging.



Figure 5 shows that 32.40% students strongly agree and 29.10% students agree that the college offered adequate choice of Elective subjects.




Which aspect/s of the Institution motivated you to join it?




Qualities Inculcated by the College

An open-ended question asked to the students was about the most likeable thing about the college. It encourages students to reflect upon their college experiences, whether it is campus environment, friendships, extracurricular activities, supportive faculty or personal growth moments. It often sparks meaningful and insightful responses. Some of the responses of the students are as follows: Good Infrastructure, Teachers, Environment, Discipline, Cleanliness, Academics, Cafeteria, Food, Co-curricular activities, Events, Diversity, Gardens, Grounds, Exposure etc.

Overall Experience


