




➤ **Photography competition to celebrate World Wetlands Day**

Date: 01.02.2025

Number of participants: 30

MCM Eco-Club 'Parivesh' and the department of Zoology under the aegis of IQAC organized an educational visit for the students of B.Sc. II & III Medical to the regulator end of Sukhna Lake and Chandigarh Bird Park on 01 February, 2025 to celebrate World Wetlands Day. Spotting Scopes, Binoculars, and Field Guides for Bird Identification, Self-explanatory Illustrative Boards regarding birds, their habitat, migration etc. were made available by the Department of Forest and Wildlife at the regulator end of the Sukhna wetland. The students saw many beautiful migratory birds like Ruddy Shelduck, Black winged stilt, Egret, Eurasian coot, Common Teal, Northern Shoveler, Purple & Grey Heron, Small cormorant, Great Cormorant, Darter, Night Heron, Pin tail, Common Shelduck etc. The students learned that the birds migrate to move from areas of low or decreasing resources to areas of high or increasing resources. The two primary resources being sought are food and nesting locations. Migration can be triggered by a combination of changes in day length, lower temperatures, changes in food supplies, and genetic predisposition. Also, the birds navigate using compass information from the sun, the stars, and by sensing the earth's magnetic field.

Further, the students visited Chandigarh Bird Park set up by the Department of Forest and Wildlife, UT Administration on 6.5 acres land at Nagar Van behind Sukhna Lake. The main attractions in the park were African love birds, budgerigars, white swan, black swan, wood duck, golden pheasant, yellow golden pheasant, green wing macaw, sun conures, African grey parrot, finches and melanistic pheasant. The facility has got two small aviaries and two walk through aviaries. The structure surrounds thousands of plants of varying canopies, which gives an ideal habitat, food and shelter for these birds so that they can freely fly and breed.

A photography competition was also organized during the visit. The students spotted and clicked various birds and animals showcasing their photography skills. The results of the photography competition are as follow:

Number of participants: 10




